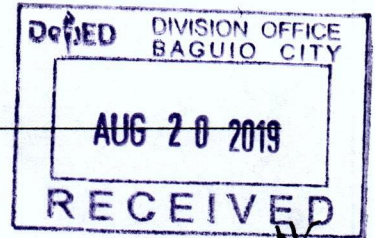



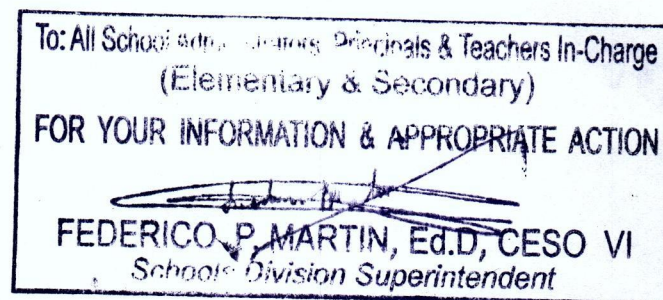
This activity will be in relation to the Baguio Day Celebration of the City of Baguio wherein these young pupils will be gauged if they are well versed on the history of our city.

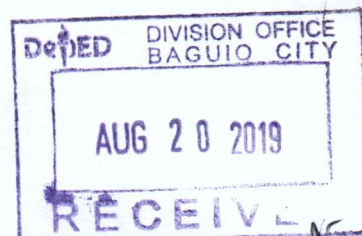

GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS OF THE CONTEST

1. The contest is open to all enrolled **Grade VI pupils of Public Elementary Schools** in Baguio City. **One contestant** per school will be accommodated.
2. Each **Contestant** together with the **Coach** must **register** at **Baguio City Public Library**. Registration date starts on **September 9, 2019** and ends on **September 14, 2019**. The Library opens Monday - Saturday at 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
3. The contest will be held on **September 17, 2019** at Baguio City Public Library. Program starts at **8:30 in the morning**. All participants and coaches must be in before the program starts.
4. Contestants may **wear** the prescribed school **uniform** or **casual attire** and school **ID** for easier identification.
5. All **personal belongings** of the contestants such as cellular phones, tablets, notebooks, books, folders, envelopes, bags, papers, and others are **not allowed** in the contest area. Official **answer sheets/ papers** and ball pens will be **provided**.
6. The quiz bee will be in **three rounds: Easy, Average, and Difficult**. Participants who got **75%** in the Easy round will advance in the Average round. Participants who got **75%** in the Average round will advance in the Difficult round. The Difficult round will determine the top ten winners. Participants who got **below 75%** in Easy and Average rounds will be **eliminated**.
7. Twelve (**12**) questions will be asked for the **Easy** round; Sixteen (**16**) questions for the **Average** round; and Twenty (**20**) questions for the **Difficult** round. Ten (**10**) questions will be prepared to **break a tie** or **ties**.
8. The library staff will **read** the question **twice**. **Countdown** will start **after** the **second** reading. Contestants are given **20 seconds** to answer each question in the **Easy** round; **18 seconds** in the **Average** round; and **15 seconds** in the **Difficult** round. A **signal** will be given to signify that the **time limit** has already **lapsed**. Contestants must **stop writing** and shall **raise** their **hand**. The **correct answer** will be **shown** with bibliographic details. Other library staff will be **assigned** in **each table** to **check** the answers of the contestants. Each **correct answer** will be given one (**1**) **point**.
9. All **questions** will be about **Baguio City**. **Questions** will be **objective** type. Proper **spelling** will be strictly **observed**. All **answers** must be **readable**.

10. Should there be a **tie** or ties after the Difficult round, five (5) **tie-breaker questions** will be given. In case of **another tie**, the remaining five (5) **tie-breaker questions** will be given.

11. Any **question** or query to the **correctness** of the **answer/s** will be entertained before the next round. The **judges** will refer to the resources used in formulating the question/s. The **decision** of the **judges** will be **final**.

12. The **contestants** who remained after the **Difficult round** will be **ranked** according to their **scores**. In case of a **tie/s**, the contestant who got **higher** will be **retained** in the rank while the **other** will **step down** to the lower rank. Only ten (10) will be declared as **winners**.

13. The **awarding** will follow **after** the quiz bee. **All contestants** and **coaches** will be given **certificates**. The **top ten (10)** will be awarded with **certificates** and **cash prizes**; the **top three (3)** will be awarded with **medals**. It is between the coach and the contestant if they will share with the cash prize. The ranking and prizes are as follows:

First place:	Gold Medal, Certificate, PhP 3,000.00
Second place:	Silver Medal, Certificate, PhP 2,000.00
Third place:	Bronze Medal, Certificate, PhP 1,000.00
4 th - 10 th placers:	Certificates, PhP 500.00 each

14. **All contestants** are **encouraged** to **visit** the **City Library** and **read resources** available at the **Local History section**.
