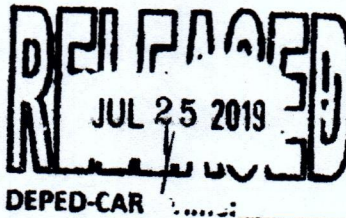

Relative to the implementation of DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017 entitled **“Research Management Guidelines”**, the Department and this Office aim to set up a mechanism to archive all completed education research conducted relevant to the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum. This will ensure the availability of evidences to support policy development, education framework, program and project implementation, plan preparation, training program design, and development of instructional materials, among others. It is understood that final reports submitted to this Office were thoroughly reviewed and approved by the Division Research Review and Evaluation Committees (DRREC).
2. In this connection, all School’s Division Offices (SDOs) are required to submit in **softcopies (Microsoft Word) all relevant research** conducted to the Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD), through email address @ pprdbenf.depedcar@gmail.com on or before **August 30, 2019**.

- An abstract is a concise summary that enables readers to quickly assess the contents and direction of the paper. *The abstract concisely describes the topic/ purpose/scope, methods, principal findings and the conclusion.*
- It should be of 150 – 250 words in one (1) paragraph, in Arial font and size of 11 pt. It must also be typed single-spaced on a standard A4 paper with 1" on the all sides.
