The BAGUIO CITY SMOKE FREE TASK FORCE will conduct a Congress highlighting its Anti-Smoking Campaign in the City of Baguio on August 27, 2019 at Venus Park View Hotel from 8:00 am onwards. The anti-smoking ordinance of the city supports also our DepEd Order No. 48 s.2016 which is the Comprehensive Tobacco Control Program of DepEd. The following activities are requested by the Task Force to be done in support of the said campaign:

1. Elementary Schools are encouraged to participate in the conduct of the Poster Making highlighting the concepts and ideas of young learners about Smoking Cigarettes and Its Ill Effects and Prevention.
2. All Grade IV, Grade V and Grade VI pupils are selected to participate.
3. The following are the materials to be used with other guidelines
 - a. The materials to be used are 1 whole sized Cartolina Paper (Preferably white in color) and any coloring or art work material.
 - b. The name, grade and section of the learner and the school where the learner came from shall be written at the back of the material at the right lower portion using ordinary pen.
 - c. All posters that were made shall be submitted to the Division Health and Nutrition Section on or before August 23, 2019 at 12:00 noon to be submitted thereafter to the City Health Services Office to be exhibited at the lobby of Venus Park View Hotel on August 27, 2019.
 - d. The Task Force Team shall select posters from among the submitted ones to be used as IEC materials during campaigns, symposiums, seminars and trainings.
 - e. Incentives are under negotiation for selected posters.
