

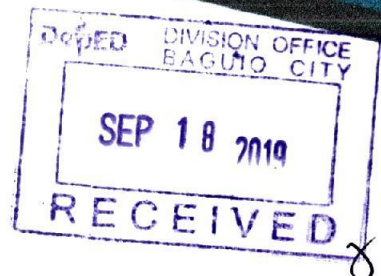

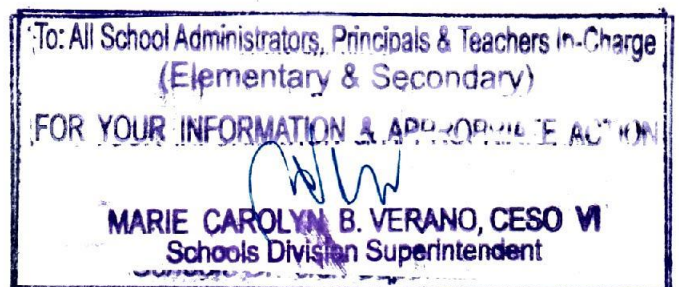

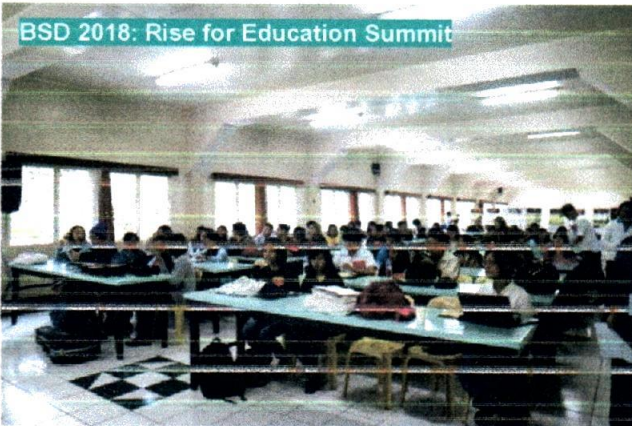

As the leading education hub in Northern Luzon, Baguio City's wide student population hails from the different provinces in Cordillera. In fact, 60% of Cordillera's student population comes from Baguio City's higher education alone. With this, the Cordilleran Youth Center, along with other youth organizations - through then Councilor Peter Fianza - lobbied and passed into legislation the *City Ordinance No. 42, s. 2013* declaring every 2nd Sunday of September as the Baguio Students' Day.

Since then, BSD has been annually celebrated through various activities – roundtable discussions, fora, summit, and cultural jams among others.

Rationale and objectives of BSD 2019

With over 20 million-strong youth vote for the recently-concluded May 2019 national and local elections, the youth has once again shown how the youth voice matters. Being dubbed as the *Pag-asa ng Bayan* (Hope of the Nation), there is a responsibility to be socially aware and involved in the plight of the Filipino people.

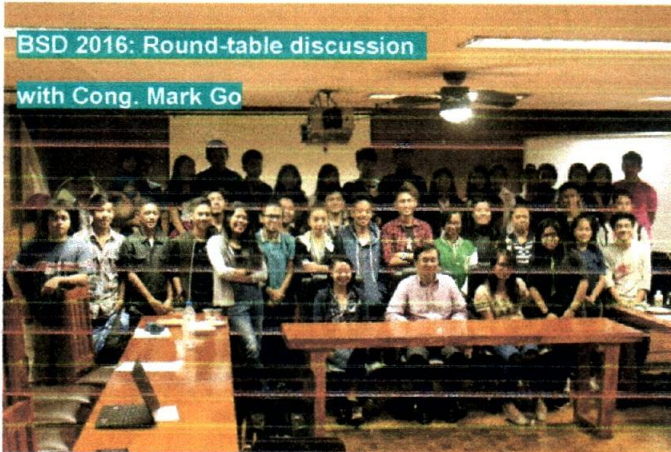

Line-up of activities



Baguio Youth Parliament: A convention of young leaders and parliamentarians from student councils, publications, organizations, and interested students from various colleges, universities and communities in Baguio to discuss national and local concerns. The convention ultimately aims to collectively craft the 2019 Baguio Youth and Students Legislative Agenda (BYSLA).

- Target participants: 150-200 pax; Members of student councils, publications, and organizations of public and private Senior High Schools, Colleges, and Universities in Baguio City
- Date: September 28, 2019; 9am – 5pm

- Venue: CAP Building, Post Office Loop, Baguio City

Round-table discussion with Baguio officials: A formal dialogue of Baguio youth and students with selected Baguio City Officials and line agencies to discuss the programs of the local government and likewise, the issues and recommendations of the youth in various concerns. As a conclusion to the Baguio Youth Parliament, the round-table discussion will serve as the venue to forward the BYSLA.

- Target participants: 40 pax; Representatives from the BYSLA Working Groups to be formed at the Baguio Youth Parliament
- Venue: IP Center (CEPMO bldg 2nd floor, in front of Baguio Children's Park)
- Date: October 5, 2019; 1pm – 5pm
