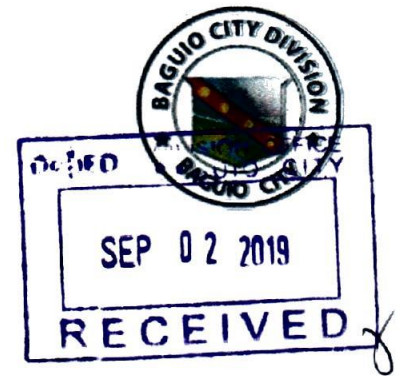

**GUIDELINES IN THE CONDUCT OF BAGUIO CENTRAL DISTRICT
MATHEMATICS FESTIVAL 2019 (Elementary)**

To: School Administrators, Principals, School Heads
Math Coaches/Coordinators
(Public and Private Schools)

Date: September 2, 2019

1. The 2019 District Mathematics Festival is scheduled on September 19 – 20, 2019 at Sto Tomas Elementary School.
2. Agreed guidelines and mechanics for the Quiz Bee and *Damath* are attached for the guidance of everyone.
3. Working committees for Quiz Bee and *Damath* are also specified for information and confirmation of the names assigned.
4. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

QUIZ BEE GUIDELINES

1. Quiz Bee will be conducted in a quiz show format (MTAP Style) where in all are seated and will show their answers to the judges at the same time.
2. Coverage of the questions will be the competencies covered from first to fourth quarter of the K – 12 Curriculum. Coaches are responsible to prepare one question each for easy, average, difficult and clincher which are good for 15 secs., 30 secs., and 1 minute respectively..
3. Questions/problems should be encoded in a ¼ of a long coupon bond divided crosswise equally in a comic sans font style, size 14 for Grades 1 to 3 and Arial font style, size 12 for Grades 4 to 6. (No choices, answer and solution should be written below each question)
4. No Mathematical term identification for the easy round. Only mental computation questions. Difficult questions should be photocopied according to the number of the quizzers. **(Copy for the quizzers should not have answer)**
5. All questions will be read twice by the quiz master except those that will be disregarded due to technicalities. Each correct answer for easy, average and difficult round will receive 2 points, 3 points and 5 points respectively.
6. In case of a tie, 3 clincher questions will be read. If result remains, Do or DIE question will follow. First to get the correct answer in the allotted time wins.
7. After the time limit, the timer signals. Contestants will automatically stop writing and will raise their answer sheet as the proctor verifies before recording it.
8. If the quiz master and the proctors cannot determine the validity of the answer, the board of judges will decide on the matter. The decision of the board of judges is final.
9. Quizzer may air her/his protest and shall be referred to the board of judges before the quizmaster reads the next question. No protest shall be entertained by the board of judges after the quizmaster has read the next question.
10. Only top three (3) winners per grade level in the district level are qualified for the division level competition and only top one from Grades 3 to 6 in the Division level will compete to regional level.

DAMATH COMPETITION GUIDELINES

1. Each school shall have two contestants per level. They will be bracketed depending on the number of entries and each player shall be permanently assigned in a bracket until the elimination round is over.
2. Moves will be alternate and should be in forward direction except when taking a chip or if the chip is a DAMA.
3. A chip is declared DAMA if it reaches and stops in any of the following opponent's squares 1,0 3,0 5,0 7,0. Similarly, an opponent's chip is declared DAMA if it reaches the following squares 1,7 2,7 4,7 6,7. DAMA number should be encircled in the score sheet for identification
4. Once a chip is declared DAMA, it could move diagonally, forward or backward in any vacant square. If a DAMA takes an ordinary chip, the score is doubled or vice versa. If a DAMA takes another DAMA, the score is quadrupled.
5. In taking chip/s, the following shall prevail:
 - Mayor dalawa # takes 0 or DAMA vs # takes 0 and 0
 - Mayor tatlo # takes/DAMA 0 and 0 vs # takes 0 and 0 and 0
 - Mayor dama # takes 0 vs DAMA takes 0
 - Mayor dama dalawa # takes/DAMA takes 0 and 0 and over mayor DAMA
6. Pass is not allowed. If player has an option, he may use the 1 minute but has to take the chip/s anyway. If a player has no option, then the game is already over.
7. No save by the bell in the last minute of the game. Continuation of move will be observed. Warning is given to a player by the arbiter if no move is made within the allotted time and consequently, he has to move his chip. Continuous violation of this rule will mean disqualification even if he is leading in the score sheet.

8. A game is only good for 20 minutes. Nevertheless, it is to be declared over if moves are repetitive, a player has no more to move or a player has no more chips.
9. The remaining chip/s of the players is/are added to the players score. If the remaining is DAMA, the value is doubled.
10. The player with the greater score wins the game.
11. Only one score sheet will be used by the players and scores will be listed in continuous manner (running score).
12. Only players are allowed to raise questions during the game through the arbiter and questions should be settled immediately. Arbiter's decision is final.
13. No complaints will be entertained after the players have signed the score sheets.
14. Defaulting time is 10 minutes.
15. As agreed during the meeting level 3 may use calculator.
16. Players should bring their own Damath board and chips.
17. Only top 5 players per category will move to the division level
