

The Last Mile School is a flagship program to close the gaps between schools in geographically challenged areas and their counterparts in urban areas in terms of school facilities, buildings, provisions of instructional and learning materials, electric and internet connectivity, and other basic inputs for Public Schools of the Future. It is an initiative to ensure that schools in far flung areas and those who have not meet the standard allocation criteria for basic inputs will not be left behind towards achieving our main thrust in providing accessible, quality, relevant, and liberating education to Filipino learners.

In this regard, Schools Division Offices (SDOs) through the Division Planning Officers (DPOs) are instructed to validate *the data of the identified Last Mile Schools* provided in the attachment, considering the existing defined parameters. In particular, the Planning Service of the Department provided instructions and the standard template that will be used and served as guide in this undertaking (*see answering guide sheet in the electronic template*). Also, the results of the validation shall be submitted to the Education Management Information System Division-Planning Service (EMISD-PS) on or before 20 September 2019 at ps.emisd@deped.gov.ph.

For smooth consolidation and processing of reports, all concerned personnel are reminded to submit the results using the template/s provided in MS Excel and not to deviate to any format.
