TIME: 8:00 A.M. – 4:00 P. M.  
VENUE: SAN VICENTE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CAMP 8, Baguio City  
REGISTRATION FEE: **Php50.00** per student contestant

**A. TECHNO-QUIZ BEE: October 9, 2019**

1. **School:** – Three representatives each school from Grade 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, & 12  
\* **TOP 3** contestants in each skill will move to the DIVISION LEVEL

2. **Tasks:** Every school to submit **5 questions each for EASY, AVERAGE and DIFFICULT. Clincher questions shall be three questions (to be taken from the easy, average, difficult questions)**

- \* The coverage of the quiz is: Home Economics, Agriculture and Fishery Arts, Industrial Arts and Entrepreneurship
- \* K to 12 content, from first grading to fourth grading content
- \* To be printed on a **long** bond paper (Font type and size: **ARIAL 12**), **no multiple choice questions, WITH KEY ANSWERS.**
- \* To be submitted during the contest day
- \* **FIVE (5)** questions on every long bond paper divided crosswise equally. (8.5" x 13")

<b>Q3 - easy 3<sup>rd</sup> grading content</b>

### **TECHNO-QUIZ GUIDELINES**

1. Each contestant will be provided with slips of paper for the answer to each question. Before the contest proper, the contestant will write the assigned number on each slip.
2. There shall be 15 questions. There are five (5) rounds in each competition namely: Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher. The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie. Questions will be read twice by the Quizmaster.
  - a. For the EASY ROUND, five questions are to be answered mentally. Writing anywhere, neither on paper, the table, etc. is not allowed. After the second (2nd) reading, the Quizmaster shall say "go". Only then will the contestants be allowed to write their answer on their slip of paper. Automatically, the fifteen (15) second time - limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
  - b. For the AVERAGE ROUND, five questions are to be answered. After the first (1st) reading, the contestants are allowed to start solving and write their final answer on the slip of paper. Automatically, the thirty (30) second time - limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
  - c. For the DIFFICULT ROUND, five questions are to be answered. The contestants are immediately allowed to solve while the quizmaster is reading the question, and write their answer on their slip of paper. A one (1) minute time limit will be given.
  - d. For the CLINCHER ROUND, three questions are to be answered. The contestant with the highest score wins. Questions will be taken from the unread difficult round questions. The contestants are immediately allowed to solve, and write their answer. A one (1) minute time limit will be given.
3. Answers must be given complete with units and to the required accuracy. However, if the unit is already given in the way the question is asked, it need not be given in the answer.
4. After the time limit and the buzzer or bell sounds, the contestants must stop writing and raise the slip of paper.
5. The Quizmaster shall read the correct answer and the judges will notify the scorers the contestants who got the correct answers.
6. Points are assigned for each question answered correctly:

. Easy question	2 point
. Average question	3 points
. Difficult question	5 points
. Clincher question	1 point
7. After the fifth (5th) question in the Difficult Round, the total number of points of each contestant is tabulated.
8. The contestant will be ranked according to their total score. The top three will proceed to the Division Level.
9. In case any qualified contestant is unable to compete in the next contest level, the next in rank will take the place of the contestant.
10. Only the duly registered teacher - coach or contestant is authorized to make a protest.
11. All protest should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question.
12. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/ protests.
