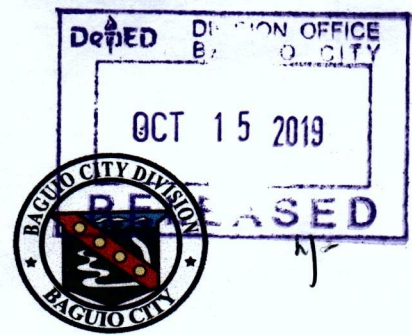

BACKGROUND

The Red Cross Youth can trace its roots back from the proposition of the Ladies Committee of Moravia, to involve children and youth in primary and intermediate schools, and universities with the work of the Red Cross and educate young people about the principles of the Red Cross Movement.

In 1892, the idea to mobilize the youth within the movement was made official at the Fifth International Conference of the Red Cross Societies in Italy.

Since then, the functions of the Red Cross Youth have evolved into something bigger than the previous intention.

Considered as one of the major services of the Philippine Red Cross, the Red Cross Youth aims to produce a nation of volunteers. Through its various activities, the youth are trained to become holistic, effective, and conscientious leaders grounded on the Seven (7) Fundamental Principles of the movement.

The month of October is dedicated as the Red Cross Youth Month. It is an activity initiated by the Philippine Red Cross that celebrates and recognizes the crucial role of the youth in humanitarian action and development. This month centers on the different youth-led activities that continue to inculcate the spirit of humanitarianism and volunteerism amongst the youth volunteers.

This year, the theme for the celebration is, "RCY GRIT: Greatness, Resiliency, Inclusivity, and Tenacity for Humanitarian Action." It encapsulates one timeless message that we would like the public to know about the Red Cross Youth - amidst the millennial era where everything is fast-paced and instant, the RCY volunteers are committed to effect positive changes in the society.
