

SUBJECT: **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN SUPPORT TO THE VICTIMS OF A
LABORATORY FIRE ACCIDENT IN KADACLAN NATIONAL HIGH
SCHOOL, BARLIG, MT. PROVINCE LAST OCTOBER 8, 2019**

DATE: **October 15, 2019**

1. On October 8, 2019 during a laboratory activity of Grade 9 students in Kadaclan NHS, Barlig, Mt. Province, an unfortunate chemical fire accident caused first to second degree thermal burns to three learners. Two of which, are still confined at Baguio General Hospital, Baguio City after being transferred from Bontoc General Hospital. The skin burns incurred by the victims worsened considering the long span of time before they reached the hospital for treatment. One of the victims was diagnosed with second degree burns on her face, chest, and arms.
2. Hence, in keeping with the Cordilleran spirit of Binnadang or Bayanihan particularly during difficult times involving our learners, the Department of Education — CAR is knocking on your hearts for whatever financial assistance you can provide in order to aid in the payment of bills and as support to the victims especially those who are still recovering in the hospital and may undergo further medical procedures.
