

- 1. Relative to the Department Memorandum Number 138, s. 2019 regarding the conduct of the National Technolympics, Dep-Ed Cordillera Administrative Region will conduct the 2019 Regional Technolympics with the theme, "Authentic Filipino Talents and Skills: Breaking the Barriers for Inclusive Education" on November 24-27, 2019 to be held in Tabuk City, Kalinga
- 2. The 2019 Regional Technolympics aims to:

- 5. The participants to the 2019 Regional Technolympics are the champions in the identified skills, their coaches and officials. Please see details in the enclosure # 2 of 2 pages. Each participant should wear a sky blue T- shirt during the first day of activity.
- 6. Tabuk City has a hot weather but may be cold in the evening. Mosquitoes are rampant so bring mosquito net and insect repellant. Bring your eating utensils, biddings and mat. All other matters will be discuss during the meeting on November 6, 2019, 3:00 pm at Manuel L. Quezon Elementary School.
- 7. There shall be no registration fee during the 2019 Regional Technolympics. However, traveling expenses of participants going to and from the venue, meals, snacks and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds or other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. Teacher- participant shall be granted a one (1) day service credit and COC to Non-teaching personnel for services rendered on November 24, 2018 that falls on a Sunday.
