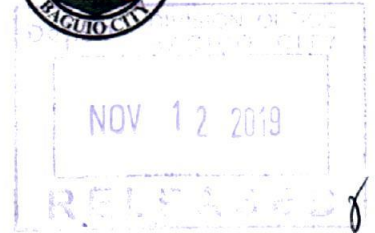

**OBSERVANCE OF THE 2019 FILIPINO VALUES MONTH**

1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum No. 161, s. 2019 and Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation no. 479 dated October 7, 1994, Schools Division of Baguio City enjoins all public and private schools to conduct school-based/district activities for the 2019 Filipino Values Month celebration.
2. This year's theme is "*Pamilyang Pilipino Patatagin: Susi sa Paghubog ng Kabataang Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan at Makabansa*". The theme of the celebration emphasizes the importance and critical role of the family in strengthening Filipino Values and developing individuals who are pro-God, pro-people, pro-country, and pro-nature especially in this digital age.
3. In view of this the suggested activities include tarpaulin display, values integration in all learning areas, Family day, symposia or seminars, film showing or stage play on current issues related to the theme, acting out alternative interventions exemplifying positive Filipino values, recollection/spiritual upliftment, Family tree poster presentation, family slogan and poster making contest, jingle/sayawit, tagis talino, life story composition, talks on the vocation for the youth, pe-marriage forums, family counseling, and other related activities for teaching and non-teaching personnel, learners, parents and stakeholders,
4. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The schools shall submit to the curriculum implementation Division, attention to Education Program Supervisor in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao on or before December 13, 2019, report that captures impact of the celebration of Filipino Values Month, which comprehensively describe the general nature of activities conducted, involvement of stakeholders, observations/Findings, issues/concerns and recommendations.
