



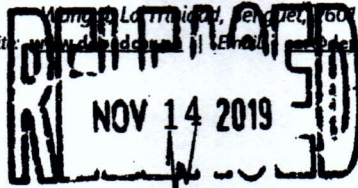

CONDUCT OF THE 2019 YOUTH FOR ENVIRONMENT IN SCHOOLS ORGANIZATION (YES-O) SUMMIT

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- The Department of Education-Cordillera Administrative Region will conduct a three (3) - day YES-O Summit with the theme: "YES FOR YOUTH EMPOWERMENT IN THE SOCIETY FOR LEADERSHIP, ENTREPRENEURSHIP, ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION, AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT IN THE 21ST CENTURY" on December 17-19, 2019 at the Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- The training aims to: (a) inspire and equip the young people to value themselves and others by developing and maintaining a positive self-image showing compassion to others, persevering in the midst of adversity and creating a daily successful attitudes and behavior for sustainable development; (b) provide a stimulating environment for participants to discuss the potential of the Cordillerans and to showcase the innovations and entrepreneurial potentials; (c) provide participants with the opportunity to expand their skills and knowledge of leadership, entrepreneurship, and empowerment for the advancement of opportunities and solutions to challenges in the education sector; (d) network with successful youth and other professionals, and learn from them and share experiences.
- The participants to this event are the Presidents of the Supreme Student Government (SSG) from all the public secondary schools, Selected School Heads, and Teacher-Advisers. (Please see attached number of participants per Schools Division).
- There will be breakout sessions in six (6) groups with four (4) student-presenters during the activity. Each student will present their policy proposal, advocacy campaign and technology innovation where they will be given feedback by two (2) specialists. The four (4) student-presenters are participants from the Schools Divisions of Abra, Baguio City, Benguet, and Tabuk City.
- Participants are expected to be at the venue by 2:00 in the afternoon on December 16, 2019, with dinner as the first meal. Check out time is 12:00 noon on December 19, 2019.
- It is requested that each school division shall submit the names of the participant, C/o Education Support Services Division through email address: essd.depedcar@gmail.com not later than December 4, 2019. The participants are requested to register online through: bit.ly/car-yes-o-summit.
- Travelling expenses of student-participants shall be charged against downloaded funds to the Schools Division Offices while school heads and teacher-advisers shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
