1. The Department of Education Cooperative (DepEdCoop), in coordination with the DepEd Employee Associations Coordinating Office (DEACO), will conduct the **Second National Convention of DepEd Cooperatives** with the theme, One DepEd Cooperative: Strengthening Collaboration and Partnership Towards Greater Success, from November 6 to 9, 2019 at the Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

2. The convention aims to

- a. strengthen the solidarity and commitment among DepEd cooperatives and their stakeholders;
- b. address priority areas for the welfare, improvement, and development of cooperatives and their members based on matters concerning the following:
 - i. Importance of Cooperatives,
 - ii. Organization/Establishment/Responsibilities of Cooperatives,
 - iii. Automatic Payroll Deduction System (APDS), and
 - iv. Gender and Development (GAD).
- c. sustain synergy among DepEd cooperatives and foster partnership with DepEd in order to attain significant success in serving the needs of their members; and
- d. enhance competencies in management and governance of cooperatives.

3. Participants in this activity are teaching and nonteaching personnel who are officers and management staff of the different DepEd cooperatives in Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. Attendance to this activity is **on official business**.

4. Those interested to establish a cooperative in the schools, as well as schools divisions and regional offices are encouraged to attend the convention.

5. A registration fee of Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for the food and accommodation, convention kits, and other giveaways, honoraria of resource persons and facilitators, and other incidental expenses charged to their respective local or cooperative funds.
