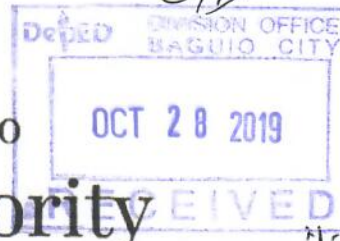



# ASTRUM SCIENTIS SORORITY

## CONTEST MECHANICS GAWAD TALA 2019

1. All bona fide senior high school students from Baguio City and Benguet are allowed to join in any of the four competitions.
2. Each participating school should have only one representative for the impromptu speech, one for the poetry writing, one for the poster-making contest, and one team made up of four members are required for the quiz show.
3. Participants are required to bring their school I.D.
4. Participants who come later than 9 in the morning are automatically disqualified.

### IMPROMPTU SPEECH

- All participants will be given one topic for his/her speech.
- He/She will be given five (5) minutes to prepare and another five (5) to seven (7) minutes to deliver the speech. Deductions will be given to contestants who exceed the allotted time.
- Coaches are not allowed inside the contest room.
- The speech shall be delivered in English medium.
- The criteria for judging are as follows:

○ Content	35%
○ Delivery	30%
○ Diction	15%
○ Voice	10%
○ Articulation	10%

### POETRY WRITING

- The participants will be provided five (5) pieces of paper each.
- Only the papers given by the proctors should remain on the desk of each participant.
- Participants will be given two (2) hours to write the poem.
- The poem shall be written in English medium
- Finished or unfinished papers will be collected by the proctors after the allotted time.
- Coaches are not allowed inside the contest room.
- Participants who are caught cheating or being coached by their advisers during the contest proper will be disqualified.
- Participants may provide their own title for their poems.
- The criteria for judging are as follows:

○ Organization	25%
○ Relevance to the theme	40%
○ Style	20%
○ Originality	15%
	<u>100%</u>

### POSTER-MAKING

- Participants should have their own art materials except for the illustration boards that will be provided for them.
- Participants will be given two (2) hours to complete their entry.
- Finished or unfinished works will be collected by the proctors after the allotted time.
- Coaches are not allowed inside the contest room.



# ASTRUM SCIENTIS SORORITY

- Participants who are caught cheating or being coached by their advisers during the contest proper will be disqualified.
- The criteria for judging are as follows:
  - Originality 25%
  - Relevance to the theme/Content 35%
  - Aesthetic Value 30%
  - Craftsmanship/Technique 10%

## QUIZ BEE

- Each team must be composed of four (4) members.
- The quiz proper will be composed of three (3) categories: the easy, average, and difficult. Each question will be given a corresponding number of points.
  - Easy 10 points each
  - Average 15 points each
  - Difficult 20 points each
- Problem solving: 25 points. (The problem solving question may be given in any of the three categories and it will constantly be scored for 25 points each regardless of the category where it will be asked).
- Easy and Average rounds have multiple-choice type of questions while the difficult round has identification-type questions.
- Math, Environmental Science, Current Events, History, Language and General Information are the disciplines where the questions will come from.
- Contestants will be given exactly ten (10) seconds to answer multiple choice type of questions, two (2) minutes to answer problem-solving type questions, and fifteen (15) seconds for the identification-type questions.
- Only four (4) highest scoring teams after the average round will be carried to the difficult round.
- After the difficult round, the scores will be summed up and the team with the highest score wins.
- In case of a tie in the final score, contestants that are competing with the place will answer a question projected on the screen. Once the question is projected, contestants may automatically answer. The team who will give the correct answer will get the higher rank.
- Each question will be read twice. After the second reading of the question, the time allotted to answer will immediately begin.
- Final answers must be encircled on the answer sheets provided. Correct answers which are not encircled are not valid. A blank sheet would mean no answer.
- Proctors assigned to each team will immediately collect the answer sheet when the allotted time is up.
- Name or abbreviation of the school represented by the contestants should be written on the upper right portion of the answer sheet.
- Anyone caught answering after the time is up will be immediately disqualified.
- There must be absolutely no coaching from the audience and the advisers. Anyone caught cheating or receiving answers from the audience will be disqualified.
- Awards will be given to the first three highest scorer team.

## AWARDS OF WINNERS

- There will be designated points for every rank obtained by the participants in each event.
- These points will be added according to the school to which the participant/s belong/s.
- The school that acquires the most points wins 1<sup>st</sup> prize followed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placers.
- Certificate of Participation will be given to all participants.
