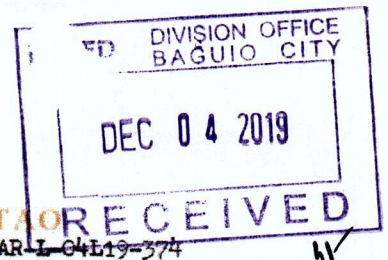

In line with the celebration of the year's National Human Rights Consciousness Week with the theme "**Youth standing up for human rights**", all government agencies, including government-owned and controlled corporations, shall celebrate the week through simple and appropriate ceremonies and activities to make the people aware of their basic human rights in relation to the functions and services offered by these government instrumentalities (Sec. 3, RA 9201).

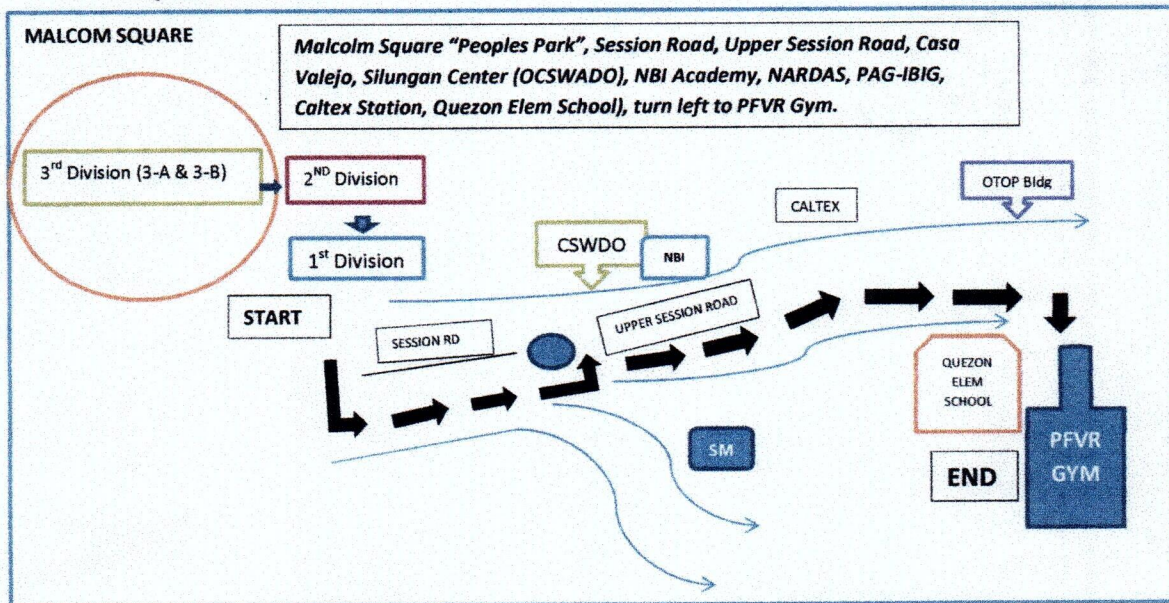

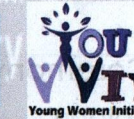
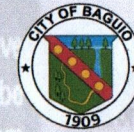
