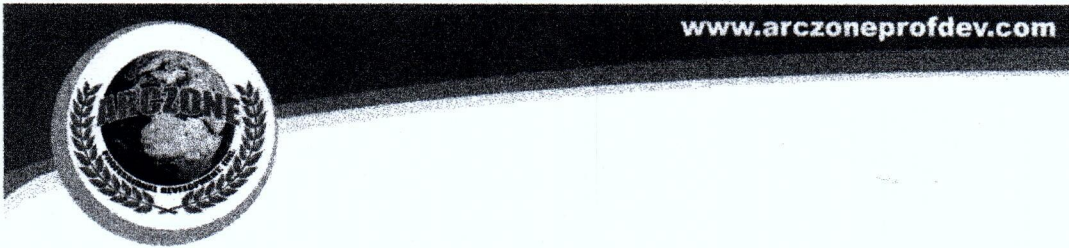

Dear Ms. Verano:

Republic Act No. 11036 otherwise known as **Mental Health Law** (June 20, 2018) stipulates in Sec. 2 that the state affirms basic right of all Filipinos to mental health as well as the fundamental rights of people who require mental health services. 

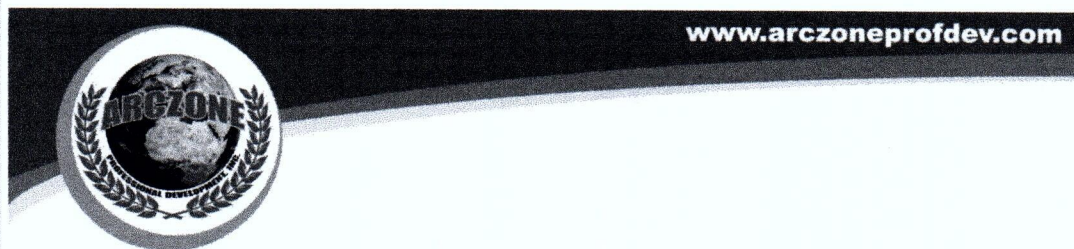
