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Enclosure no. 1 **EVENTS AND GUIDELINES**

The general guidelines of the competitions of every event to be undertaken are as follows:

A. BIBLE QUIZ BEE

1. There shall be three (3) participants per team, coming from the Grade 4 to 6, both from Public and Private schools.
2. Each coach is entitled to submit (2) multiple choice questions with three (3) choices. The teams will compete in the Easy, Average, and difficult category, one (1) point will be given to each questions. Easy questions will be on names found in the bible, Average is on events and places and difficult category will be about the different books found in the bible. eg. What book can we find the verse for with God nothing shall be impossible? (a. Romans B. Luke C. Acts
What Book can we find the Creation of God? A. Genesis b. Exodus C. Leviticus
3. The coverage of the quiz bee questions will be from Genesis to Revelation. All questions will be in English using the New American Standard Bible.
4. The five participants with the highest scores will be declared winners (Champion, 1st runner up, 2nd runner up, 3rd runner up, and 4th runner up.
5. The top 3 district winners will represent the North Quezon District to the Division Bible Quiz Bee on January 29, 2020.
6. There shall be one (1) rank for public and private schools.
7. Coach from each participating schools shall submit three questions for each category (easy, - average, difficult) to the quiz bee committee with the following format:
 - 7.1. One fourth of long bond paper (crosswise)
 - 7.2. Font: Times new Roman
 - 7.3. Font size: 16
 - 7.4. With three choices
8. In case of a tie a clincher will be given which will be taken from the remaining questions of each category.

B. BIBLE DRILL

1. There shall be one (1) participant from the team coming from the Grade 4 to 6, both from Public and Private schools.
2. Each coach is entitled to submit (1) verse from the bible.
3. The participant will compete for five (5) verses.
4. The coverage of the bible drill will be from the New Testament.
5. The five participants with the highest scores will be declared winners (Champion, 1st runner up, 2nd runner up, 3rd runner up, and 4th runner up.
6. There shall be one (1) rank for public and private schools.

C. BEST IN MEMO REVERSE

1. There shall be one (1) participant from the team coming from the Grade 4 to 6, both from Public and Private schools.
2. Each participant will memorize as many verses as they can for the period of one (1) minute. Number of verses memorized will be the participant's score.
3. The coverage of the memo reverse will be from the Old and New Testament.
4. The five participants with the highest scores will be declared winners (Champion, 1st runner up, 2nd runner up, 3rd runner up, and 4th runner up).
5. There shall be one (1) rank for public and private schools.

D. MOST DISCIPLINED TEAM

1. Participants are from the different schools of North Quezon from Public and Private schools.
2. Participants are advised to wear their uniforms.
3. Each school will be given a placard and designated place for the participants to stay.
4. The Most disciplined team will be based from the observation of the judge on the character and attitude shown by the participants from the start up to the end of the program.
5. The five participants with the highest scores will be declared winners (Champion, 1st runner up, 2nd runner up, 3rd runner up, and 4th runner up).
6. There shall be one (1) rank for public and private schools.
