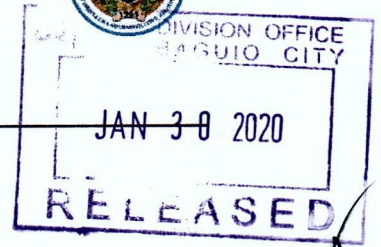

**CONDUCT OF 17<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL SCIENCE QUEST**

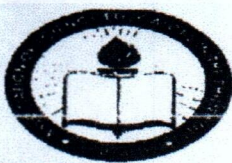

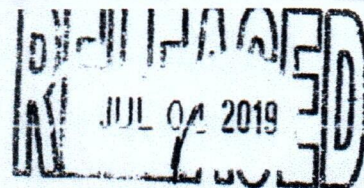
