

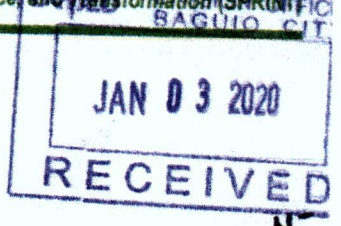

CONTEST GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

7th Easter College Academic and Skills Festival

February 7, 2020

A. General Guidelines:

1. All participants must be currently enrolled for the school 2019-2020 in any private or public school.
2. There will be three categories: Elementary, Junior High School, and Senior High School.
3. A contestant is allowed to join in more than one event provided that there is no conflict in the schedule and shall pay the registration fee in each event.
4. Participating school may field a maximum of three (3) groups/ contestants in any of the events.
5. A minimal registration fee of Php 50.00 will be charged from each participant to defray expenses relative to the conduct of the activity.
6. All decisions of the Board of Judges and Chairpersons will be final and irrevocable.
7. Top three winners in spelling bee, quiz bee, bible quiz bee, spoken word poetry, and extemporaneous speech will be given medals and certificate of recognition while trophy and certificate of recognition will be given to top three winners in hip-hop and cultural dances. Certificate of participation will be given to all participants. Trophy will be given to Over-All Champion, Over-All 1st Runner-Up, and Over-All 2nd Runner-Up.
8. Determination of over-all winners:

C. Specific Guidelines:

1. Quiz Bee

- a. Each group should be composed of three (3) members.
- b. Coaches or contestants are required to submit one (1) identification type question or worded problem each for Science, Mathematics, and English. It should be type/computer or hand written in a one fourth crosswise of a bond paper. (Note: One set of questions per school NOT per group.)
- c. The quiz master shall read the question twice; then, give a signal for the start of the time. For questions involving computations, the contestants may take note the given and start solving while the quiz master is reading the question.
- d. Contestant must write their final answer on the answer board provided. This shall be raised as soon as the corresponding time for each question has elapsed (10 seconds and 30 seconds for questions requiring computations).
- e. Answer with incorrect spelling, non observance of capitalization, without unit is rendered wrong.

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- f. All questions must be submitted to the contest committee before the start of the contest.
- g. In case of last minute change of answer, cross out the previous answer and encircle the final answer.
- h. All protest shall be raised immediately before the next question is read. Protest shall be directed to the Chairman of the Board and shall be decided upon by the board whose decision is deemed final and irrevocable.
- i. Coverage:

- j. All protest should be raised before the quizmaster reads the next question; otherwise, it will not be entertained.

2. Bible Quiz Bee

- a. Each group should compose of three (3) members.
- b. Coaches or contestants are required to submit one (1) identification type question each for people, events and places. It should be type/computer or hand written in a one fourth crosswise of a bond paper. (Note: One set of questions per school NOT per group.)
- c. The quiz master shall read the question twice; then, give a signal for the start of the time (10 seconds). Contestants may write their answer while the quiz master is reading the question.
- d. Contestant must write their final answer on the answer board provided. This shall be raised as soon as the corresponding time for each question has elapsed.
- e. Answer with incorrect spelling and non observances of capitalization are rendered wrong.
- f. All questions must be submitted to the contest committee before the start of the contest.
- g. All protest shall be raised immediately before the next question is read. Protest shall be directed to the Chairman of the Board and shall be decided upon by the board whose decision is deemed final and irrevocable.
- h. Coverage:

Elementary	-	Four Gospels
Junior High School	-	Acts and Epistles
Senior High School	-	Pentateuch
- i. All protest should be raised before the quizmaster reads the next question; otherwise, it will not be entertained.

3. Spelling Bee

- a. Each group should compose of three (3) members.
- b. Coaches or contestants are required to submit three (3) spelling words (one easy, one average, and one difficult), using the Standard English. It should be type/computer or hand written in a one fourth crosswise of a bond paper. (Note: One set of questions per school NOT per group.)
- c. All spelling words should be used in a sentence which shall be submitted to the contest committee before the start of the contest. Definition of such word must be provided as well.
- d. Time allotment and point per category are as follows:

Easy	-10 seconds	- 1 pt.
Average	- 15 seconds	- 2 pts.
Difficult	- 20 seconds	- 3 pts.
- e. The quiz master shall read the question twice; then, give a signal for the start of the time. Contestant must write their final answer on the answer board provided. This shall be raised as

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soon as the corresponding time for each question has elapsed. Contestants may write their answer while the quiz master is reading the question.

- f. All protest shall be raised immediately before the next question is read. Protest shall be directed to the Chairman of the Board and shall be decided upon by the board whose decision is deemed final and irrevocable.

4. Extemporaneous Speech

- a. The topic shall be given on the spot by the judges.
- b. The contestant shall be given 3 minutes to prepare and 3 minutes to deliver.
- c. The style of the delivery should be conversational, oratorical or combination of both.
- d. The contestant should not wear his/her school uniform.
- e. Use of sound effect and props is strictly prohibited.
- f. Criteria for Judging:

Content, Clarity and Organization	40%
Pronunciation, Enunciation, Diction	20%
Delivery	20%
Stage Presence (Eye Contact, Poise, Personality)	20%

5. Spoken Word Poetry

- a. The spoken word piece to be performed should be 100% original. Each participant should provide 3 photocopies of their spoken word piece on the day of the competition to the board of judges.
- b. Each participant is given a maximum of 4 minutes to deliver the piece. Beyond this limit, 3% will be deducted from the participant's average score.
- c. The participant may deliver the piece with or without a transcript.
- d. While spoken word lends itself to free speech, the use of invectives, curse words, and any sexual innuendos is highly discouraged. Let us maintain a school-friendly atmosphere throughout the competition.
- e. The contest piece must revolve around the following themes:
 - *for Junior High School:*
 - ✓ Resiliency of the Filipino People
 - ✓ Ang Bagong Mukha ng Bayani
 - *for Senior High School:*
 - ✓ Brave Young Voices
 - ✓ Ang Papel ng Komedyang sa Bagong Lipunan
- f. The following are the criteria for judging:

Content (Imagery, Attitude, and Personality) -	30%
Voice Projection and Expression -	30%
Enunciation -	25%
Facial Expressions and Gestures -	15%
TOTAL -	100%

6. Hip-hop Dance

- a. Each group must have six to ten (6-10) members.
- b. The dance should not be more than five (5) minutes. Beyond this limit, 3% will be deducted from the group's average score.
- c. The members of the groups maybe composed of all males or females, or any combination thereof.
- d. Folk dances or accompaniment of folk music is not allowed.
- e. The competition music must not contain inappropriate, lewd or offensive language.
- f. The use of pyrotechnic gadgets, a smoke or combustible material as props is not allowed.

- g. Backdrops, scenery are permitted provided they can be carried on, set up and removed within 10 seconds of being called on to the stage or at the completion of the performance.
- h. Removing pieces of clothing during the performance is permitted provided it is not offensive or out of character. Clothing that is too short, suggestive or inappropriate for the age of the performer is not allowed. Tap shoes, jazz shoes, high-heeled shoes and bare feet are prohibited.
- i. The criteria for judging are the following:

7. Cultural Dance

- a. Each group must have twelve to twenty (12 – 20) members who shall perform any cordilleran cultural dance with live accompaniment. No recorded music is allowed including entrance and exit.
- b. No medley (combination) of the different dances shall be made.
- c. A short introduction of the dance must be presented or read before the actual performance.
- d. The performance should not be more than ten (10) minutes. Beyond this limit, 3% will be deducted from the group's average score.
- e. The members of the group maybe composed of all males or females, or any combination thereof.
- f. Backdrops, scenery are permitted provided they can be carried on, set up and removed within 10 seconds of being called on to the stage or at the completion of the performance.
- g. The criteria for judging are the following:
