



ADDITIONAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COUNCIL SCOUT JAMBOREE

1. Anent to the conduct of the Council Scout Jamboree on March 5 - 8, 2020 at Barangay Sta. Cecilia, Aringay, La Union, may we request that participating Schools/Districts bring the following equipments/materials:
 - a. For the Band - Kitchen wares (spoons, cups, water galloons, plates & others)
 - b. Kadang-kadang (per district)
 - c. Costume and props (for the Cultural Presentation)
 - d. Magnifying glass and scissors (8 per district for the World Scout Environment Program)
 - e. Respective Sectional Program (Boy, Senior and Rover Scouting) caps
2. Attached are the requirements for the Scouts Got Talent activity.

I. **BANDA RITO BANDA ROON** (Minimum of 8 Scouts)

- a. One entry per District/Private School and one entry for Secondary School
- b. A minimum of eight (8) campers will participate including the lead vocalist
- c. The band will perform maximum of 7 minutes including the entrance and exit.
- d. The band is to perform one song (no medley) of its free choice and a contest piece (" A SPIRIT OF UNITY " for Secondary) and (" LIPAD "for Elementary)
- e. The contest piece and free choice will be judged

Contest piece - 70% Free Choice - 30%
- f. Materials for the band are kitchen wares like spoons, cups, galloons, plates and others
- g. The judge's decision is final and irrevocable
- h. The criteria for judging

○ Costume (BSP uniform)	10 %
○ Variation of Musical instruments	20 %
○ Interpretation	30 %
○ Overall impact	20 %
○ Mastery of piece	<u>20 %</u>

II. TALENTS UNLIMITED

Guidelines and Mechanics:

- a. Open to all campers both individual and group of individuals. A group consist of at least 2 members
- b. Performance/Presentation must be descent and wholesome
- c. Performance/Presentation found to be offensive to the public will be automatically disqualified from the competition
- d. No using of deadly weapons, flames or and hazardous materials
- e. Each contestant will be allowed to perform a minimum of 3 minutes and maximum of 5 minutes including entrance and exit, 5% of the contestants' points will be deducted for each minute or part of a minute the contestant performed less or 3 minutes or over 5 minutes in length
- f. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable
- g. Contestant shall take charge of his/her props and costume
- h. Talent will be judged on the following criteria:

○ Talent (Music, ability, coordination)	30%
○ Creativity (uniqueness of talent and originality)	20%
○ Poise (confidence, cover mistakes well, etc.)	15%
○ Physical appearance (neatness, costume)	10%
○ Stage Presence	10%
○ Over-all impression	<u>15%</u>
Total	100%

III. **CULTURAL PRESENTATION** (during the Grand Campfire)

- a. Each Sub-Camp will have w entries (the two (2) winners in the Sub-Camp Campfire will be the entry of the Sub-Camp)
- b. Participants will be given a minimum of 5 and maximum of 7-minute presentation including entrance and exit
- c. The choice of music will be the discretion of the presenter whether it is canned or live music
- d. A minimum of 15 and a maximum of 30 performers including the instrumentalists (if alive music will be used) and props men
- e. Performers will be judged according to the following criteria:

○ Groove and Mastery	-	30%
○ Choreography and Style	-	30%
○ Cultural Appeal	-	30%
○ Costume and Props	-	<u>10%</u>
Total		100%

- f. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
