

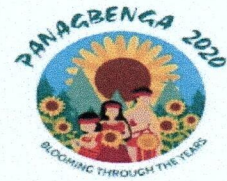

THEME: BLOOMING THROUGH THE YEARS**



**CONTEST GUIDELINES**

1. The contest is open to all Public and Private Elementary and Secondary schools in the City of Baguio.
2. There are two categories, namely Small and Big School Categories: Separate entry of Elementary from Secondary.
3. Only one entry per school is allowed either big or small category only.
4. **The BFFI reserves the right to merge the categories if one category from elementary and secondary has less than eight (8) entries.**
5. Only schools who have accomplished the required registration form, duly received by the DepEd Baguio City Schools Division shall be eligible to join the contest (details and other specifications such as location, area, person in charge should be expressly stated).
6. Entries/gardens must be prepared before the scheduled judging dates, final judging is on **March 4-6, 2020**. Since it is school-based landscaping contest, the judging/evaluation will **specify one (1) focal Area only as contingent and it should be sustained throughout the year.**
7. The school's entry shall be located within the school campus and must be open to the public for viewing starting on February 2, 2020.
8. **Fifty percent (50%) of herbs and other edible plants will be added to ornamental plants.**
9. For **big category** it must be not more than **100 sq.ft** but not less than **80 sq.ft**, and for **small category** it must be not less than **50sq.ft**. and not more than **70 sq.ft**
10. Entries must have photos taken before, during and after development of the landscape for the Baguio Flower Festival, with the photos bearing a time stamp in the photo as to the date taken
11. Copies of submitted photos of the landscaping become property of the BFFFI after the competition whether or not the entry is winning or not.
12. Judges' decision is final.

Submission of entries **are still acceptable** from 8am- 5 pm only until February 21,2020. Please submit at CID Office c/o Ms Manzano (Cp. 0948-143-1060)

**LANDSCAPING JUDGING CRITERIA**

Creative Design	25%
Herbs, ornamental and edible plants Craftsmanship	15%
Artistic Merit	15%
Thematic Interpretation	10%
Floral and Color Presentation	15%
Dramatic Impact	20%
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>100%</b>

The winners shall be determined on the basis of the ranking affected by the judges' rating. The decision of the judges' will be final and non-appealable.
