The National Youth Commission (NYC) in partnership with JTB Corp. and the Embassy of Japan in Manila, opens the application to the JENESYS 2019 Washoku (Japanese Cuisine) which will be held on 17-25 March 2020 in Tokyo, Japan. The program aims to create a mutual understanding among the people of Japan and the Asia-Pacific region, and to encourage an understanding of Japan's economy, society, history, diverse culture, politics and diplomatic relations.
2. NYC will be sending 23 youth delegates to the program. The qualifications for youth delegates are as follows:
  - enrolled Filipino students majoring in culinary arts or young professionals who are lifestyle journalists/writers
  - 18-35 years old
  - with good communication skills in English
  - Philippine passport holder (valid until September 26, 2020)
  - has never been to Japan
  - mentally and physically fit to travel, must not be pregnant
  - must be able to attend the pre-departure briefing on March 16, 2020 at NYC main office
  - must be willing to be an NYC volunteer or to participate in post-program activities
