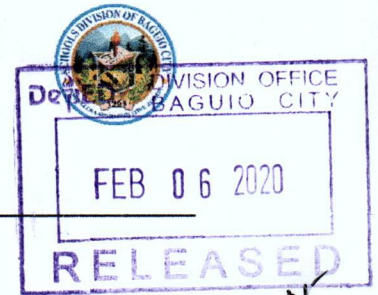

**CONDUCT OF QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR INCOMING GRADE 7
STUDENTS OF BAGUIO CITY NATIONAL SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL**

To: Public School District Supervisors
Public and Private Elementary School Heads/ Principals
All other concerned

1. This is to inform the field of the following guidelines in the conduct of the Pre-Qualifying Examination for incoming Grade 7 students at the Baguio City National Science High School.

a. Applicants should have no grade lower than 80% in all subjects from first to third grading periods in Grade VI.

b. Grades in Science VI, English VI, and Mathematics VI must be 85% and above in the three (3) quarters.

c. Grade VI students from the private schools who started their classes in July or August may submit their second quarter grades but with conditional status until the submission of their third quarter grades bearing same as in a & b above.

d. Application forms are now available at the BCNSHS guidance office with PhP 300.00 registration fee to cover expenses during the conduct of the examination. Applicants are to bring 2 pcs 2x2 ID picture with name tag, and photocopy of the School Form 138 bearing the third quarter grades.


e. Application period will start from February 3 to March 10, 2020.

2. The date of the Pre-qualifying examination will be on March 14, 2020 at the Baguio City National Science High School, Irisan, Baguio City from 8:00 AM - 11:30 AM. Examinees are expected to bring with them their permits, pencils and ball pens.

3. The Regional Final Qualifying Examination will be on April 4, 2020 at the BCNSHS campus at 8:00 am -11:30 am.

4. Service credits and compensatory Time (CTO) shall be granted to identified teachers and personnel who will be serving as proctors and monitor during Saturdays.

5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.
