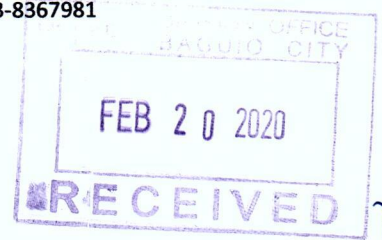

Part of our preparatory activities for the competition, is the conduct of **Basic Robotics and Coding Workshop** for the Teachers in Baguio City, to be held on **March 12, 2020, Thursday, (8:00 AM to 12:00 NN - 1<sup>st</sup> Batch; 1:00 to 5:00 PM - 2<sup>nd</sup> Batch) at Baguio-Benguet Community Credit Cooperative, 56 Cooperative St., Assumption Road, Baguio City**. This workshop will introduce them to the world of robotics engineering, electronics and programming. The fundamental knowledge and hands-on experience they gain will help them assist their prospective student-participants with the development of methods and strategies for achieving high performance.

In view of the above, may we request the support of your office by way of extending this information to schools under your division and to help us encourage them to participate on the following events:

1. **Basic Robotics and Coding Workshop for the Teachers on 12 March 2020 (Thursday)**. A minimal fee of P200.00 will be charged to every participant, inclusive of the Certificate of Completion. **Slot will be first come, first served basis.**
2. Our **2<sup>nd</sup> Baguio City Robotics Cup Open on 26 April 2020 (Sunday)**. The regular registration fee for the competition is P900.00 per team member. A discounted rate of P750.00 per team member will be charged if registered and paid on or before **March 31, 2020 (Tuesday)**. The cost covers the event facilities, ceremonies, certificates, and logistics. **Robotics Kit not included.**


