

**ADMINISTRATION OF PROGRAMME FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ASSESSMENT (PISA) 2021 FIELD TRIAL SCHEDULE AND SCHEME**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2017, the Philippines through the DepEd has signed its participation to the P Programme for International Assessment (PISA) of which the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) spearheads the PISA 2021 Field Trial administration in the country and serves as the National Center (NC)
2. Aims of the PISA are:
  - a. evaluate education systems worldwide by testing the skills and knowledge of 15-year-old students, who are approaching the end of their compulsory education.
  - b. assess their 15-year-olds in the three cognitive domains: Reading, Mathematics, and Science.
3. In preparation for the PISA Main Survey (MS) in 2021, a Field Trial (FT) will be conducted in March 2020 in 31 select schools in the country using a Computer-Based Assessment (CBA) scheme.
4. Relative to the conduct and after a multi-stage sampling procedure done by the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) and approved by the PISA international contractor, an orientation, monitoring, testing and installation of program software is scheduled on March 5 and March 11, 2020 at Pines City National High School which is the identified school.
