
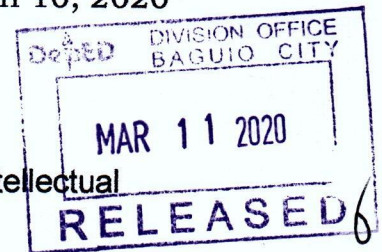

The Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOP HL) would like to thank you for the full support you extend to the Young IP Advocates (YIPA) Program. The YIPA is an initiative program of IPOP HL to empower students in the secondary level to be more creative and innovative. It also aims to help them imbibe respect for the IP rights of others and value their own creation at school and in the future.

Through DepEd-Baguió City Division's Memorandum and the efforts of Dr. Jaqueline Lampac, Science Supervisor, in inviting secondary schools to the IP Youth Camp in Baguió City last September 5-6, 2019, IPOP HL was able to bring together 17 schools with a total of 35 students inducted as Young IP Advocates. In the two-day camp, the students had interactive sessions of learning and appreciating the importance and the value of respecting IP.
