INVITATION TO BID FOR

CY 2019 Basic Educational Facilities Fund Repair of Classrooms at Dontogan Elementary School

1. The *Department of Education, Schools Division of Baguio City*, through the *CY 2019 Basic Educational Facilities Fund* intends to apply the sum of *Seven Million Eight Hundred Ninety Thousand Forty Six Pesos and 42/100 only (P 7,890,046.42)* being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for *CY 2019 Basic Educational Facilities Fund Repairs of Classrooms at Dontogan Elementary School*. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The *Department of Education, Schools Division of Baguio City* now invites bids for *2019 Basic Educational Facilities Fund Repairs of Classrooms at Dontogan Elementary School*. Completion of the Works is required *within 150 calendar days*, with the starting date to commence within seven (7) calendar days upon the Contractor's receipt of the Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act."

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from *Department of Education, Schools Division of Baguio City, #82 Military Cut-Off, Baguio City* and inspect the Bidding Documents at www.depedpines.com or the address given from *8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday to Friday*.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on *November 20, 2019* from the address below and *upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Ten Thousand Pesos only (Php10,000.00)*.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, www.depedpines.com, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

6. The *Department of Education, Schools Division of Baguio City* will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **November 29, 2019, 9:00 AM** at *Department of Education, Schools Division of Baguio City Conference Hall, # 82 Military Cut-Off, Baguio City*, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before **December 11, 2019, 9:00 AM**. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause 18**.

Bid opening shall be on **December 11, 2019, 10:00 AM** at *Department of Education, Schools Division of Baguio City Conference Hall, # 82 Military Cut-Off, Baguio City*. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. Contractors under Small A and Small B categories without similar experience on the contract to be bid may be allowed to bid if the cost of such contract is not more than the Allowable Range of Contract Cost (ARCC) of their registration based on the guidelines as prescribed by the PCAB.
9. The *Department of Education, Schools Division of Baguio City* reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

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



Contract Agreement Form No. 001, s. 2020

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this 7th day of February, 2020 by and between the Department of Education, **Schools Division of Baguio City**, located at **#82 Military Cut-Off, Baguio City** represented herein by its **Schools Division Superintendent, MARIE CAROLYN B. VERANO, CESO V**, hereinafter referred to as the "Owner" of the one part and **JJJ-A Construction**, represented herein by its **General Manager/ Proprietor, Mr. JOHNSON P. ISICAN**, with office address at #131 Upper Crystal Cave, Baguio City hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor" of the other part;

WHEREAS, the Entity is desirous that the Contractor execute *CY 2019 Basic Educational Facilities Fund Repair and Rehabilitation of Classrooms at Dontogan Elementary School* (hereinafter called "the Works") and the Entity has accepted the Bid for **Seven Million Four Hundred Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Nine Pesos and 97/100 only (P7,414,889.97)** by the Contractor for the execution and completion of such Works and the remedying of any defects therein.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract hereinafter referred to;
2. The following documents shall be attached, deemed to form, and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, to wit:
 - (a) General and Special Conditions of Contract;
 - (b) Drawings/Plans;
 - (c) Specifications;
 - (d) Invitation to Bid;
 - (e) Instructions to Bidders;
 - (f) Bid Data Sheet;
 - (g) Addenda and/or Supplemental/Bid Bulletins, if any;
 - (h) Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;
 - (i) Eligibility requirements, documents and/or statements;
 - (j) Performance Security;
 - (k) Notice of Award of Contract and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
 - (l) Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Entity.
3. The contract duration or completion period shall be 150 calendar days reckoned seven (7) calendar days from receipt of the Notice to Proceed by the contractor;

4. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Entity to the Contractor as hereinafter mentioned, the Contractor hereby covenants with the Entity to execute and complete the Works and remedy any defects therein in conformity with the provisions of this Contract in all respects;
5. The Entity hereby covenants to pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution and completion of the Works and the remedying of defects wherein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of this Contract at the times and in the manner prescribed by this Contract;
6. The Contract Price shall be paid to the Contractor through the Government disbursing procedures subject to the payment, retention money, and warranty provisions in the General Conditions of Contract, the Special Conditions of Contract, and the IRR of RA 9184;
7. The Contractor shall pay the Owner for Liquidated Damages (LD), and not by way of penalty, an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion of the works for every day of delay. The Owner shall deduct the liquidated damages from payments or any money due or which may become due the Contractor under this contract and/or collect such liquidated damages from the retention money or other securities posted by the Contractor whichever is convenient to the Owner. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of this contract, the Owner shall rescind this Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to the Owner;
8. The Contractor shall post a Warranty Security valid for one (1) year from the date of Certificate of Final Acceptance issued by the Owner in any of the following amounts and forms:

5% of the Contract Price	Cash; or Letter of Credit issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank; if issued by a foreign bank, the LC shall be confirmed or authenticated by a Universal or Commercial Bank
10% of the Contract Price	Bank Guarantee confirmed by a Universal or Commercial Bank

9. The Division Procurement Implementation Team (DPRIT), Division Inspectorate Team for Infrastructure, school head, physical facilities coordinator, school inspectorate committee and members of PTA/SGC, are authorized to monitor the project;
10. Removed/Salvaged/Replaced Materials should remain as property of the school;
11. The project engineer duly assigned by the contractor will update the school/procuring entity on the progress of the project twice a month using the template to be provided before the start of the project;
12. Contractor shall likewise:
 - a. bring own water tank and procure own water supply;
 - b. use CR but is in charge of cleanliness and siphoning of septic tank (upon 90% project completion);
 - c. pay share in electric bill and must install sub meter;

- d. require its own workers to have IDs and if possible, uniforms for easy identification and to prevent unauthorized persons entering the school premises specially at night;
 - e. allot at least 15 minutes for cleaning before the end of working hours (areas accessed by students affected by the work);
 - f. require workers strictly not to smoke and drink alcohol at any time inside the school premises and work site;
 - g. require workers to properly dispose momma and garbage which must be segregated;
 - h. require workers that the barracks will be strictly for authorized workers only (no family members allowed to stay overnight);
 - i. workers to observe "No-contact" rule with students of the subject school;
 - j. Install warning device/signs and perimeter fence where necessary to keep students away from site hazards;
13. The contractor shall conduct site clearing before turnover;
 14. The amount of the advance payment of 15% of the Contract Price is to be released to contractor upon issuance of the Notice to Proceed and upon the availability of man power and functional equipment, materials and project billboard on site;
 15. Project Engineer, Project General Manager, and Foreman must be present on site on all working days.


