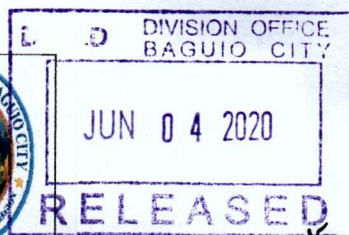

 SPECIAL PROGRAM IN THE ARTS (SPA) AND SPECIAL PROGRAM IN SPORTS (SPS)
 QUALIFYING EXAMINATIONS FOR INCOMING GRADE 7, SCHOOL YEAR 2020 – 2021**

1. This is to announce the schedule of **BAGUIO CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL QUALIFYING EXAMINATIONS** for the following **SPECIAL PROGRAMS**:

A. SPECIAL PROGRAM IN JOURNALISM (SPJ) – ENGLISH & FILIPINO

TEST DATE : JUNE 16, 2020 (tentative)

It aims to strengthen free and responsible journalism in Junior High School and develop the learners' skills required in mass communication particularly in print and broadcast media. Its focus is primarily on the mastery of competencies required to land a noble and prolific career in journalism. Admission is open to all incoming Grade 7 learners who exhibit talent in journalism based on the results of the qualifying examinations and interview to be conducted by the school screening committee.

Requirements:

- a. Duly accomplished application form (for offline application)
- b. Two (2) latest and identical 2" x 2" pictures with name tag, white background
- c. Photocopy of Grade 6 Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal
 OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCNHS Guidance Counselor

Grade requirement

General Average from 1 st to 3 rd Grading Period OR Final General Average should be 85% or higher
Average grade from 1 st to 3 rd Grading Period OR Final Rating in English should be 85% or higher
Average grade from 1 st to 3 rd Grading Period OR Final Rating in Filipino should be 85% or higher

- d. Photocopy of certificates of recognition for applicants who have participated and won in previous school, division, regional or national schools press conferences (if available)
- e. One Hundred Fifty Pesos examination fee for test materials, snacks/meals for testing personnel

B. SPECIAL PROGRAM IN SPORTS (SPS)

TEST DATES : JUNE 23 & 24, 2020 (tentative)

Requirements:

- a. Duly accomplished application form (for offline application)
- b. Two (2) latest and identical 2" x 2" pictures with name tag, white background
- c. Photocopy of Grade 6 Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal
 OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCNHS Guidance Counselor

Grade requirement

1st to 3rd Grading Average Grade of 80 % or higher OR a Final Grade of 80 % or higher in Physical Education (P.E.) and no failing grade (below 75%) in the other subjects

- d. Medical Certificate (issued by any licensed private or government Physician except BCNHS Physician)
- e. Certifications/Certificates that applicant was involved in sports-related activities/competitions
- f. One Hundred Fifty Pesos examination fee for test materials, snacks/meals for testing personnel

C. SPECIAL PROGRAM IN THE ARTS (SPA)**TEST DATES : JUNE 25 & 26, 2020 (tentative)****Requirements:**

- a. Duly accomplished application form (*for offline application*)
- b. Two (2) latest and identical 2" x 2" pictures with name tag, white background
- c. Photocopy of Grade 6 Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCHS Guidance Counselor

Grade requirement (Third OR Fourth Grading Period)

A General Average of 83 % or higher and no grade lower than 80 % in any subject

- d. Medical Certificate (*issued by any licensed private or government Physician except BCNHS Physician*)
- e. One Hundred Fifty Pesos examination fee for test materials, snacks/meals for testing personnel

Areas:

- (a) **DANCE** - Develop learners' techniques, movement, vocabulary and a deeper understanding of dance as a form of communication and expression.
- (b) **MEDIA ARTS** - Teach learners to use elements and tools of current and emerging technologies to create works that express feelings and ideas; learners will be trained to analyze and create work through photography, video, audio, computer arts, interactive media and film production.
- (c) **THEATER ARTS** - Give emphasis on group work skills and live performance of spoken text in a number of styles and genres; contemporary and classical acting techniques.
- (d) **VISUAL ARTS** - Help learners discover what they can produce through their own creativity through paintings, printmaking, creative crafts and designs, computer graphics, sculpture, etc.
- (e) **MUSIC :Band,- Rondalla & Vocal (Choir)** - Designed for dedicated music learners with interest in vocal or instrumental music.
Band Instruments : Flute, Trumpets, Altosax, Clarinets, Tenor Sax, Trombones, Percussion/Drums
Rondalla Instruments : Violin, Guitar, Banduria, Octavina, Bass

2. Filing period and modes of application: June 8 to 19, 2020


