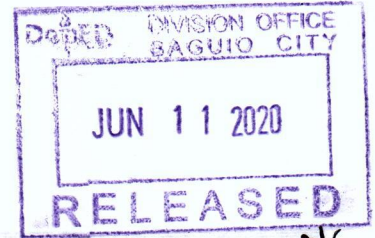



**ENFORCING 100% MOMA FREE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEMENTARY
AND SECONDARY SCHOOL FACILITIES**

TO: Chiefs, CID and SGOD
Public Schools District Supervisors
School Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools
Administrators/Principals, Private Elementary and Secondary Schools, and
All Others Concerned

1. In order to promote responsible chewing of *moma* for public health and cleanliness, the City Council of Baguio issued the Ordinance Numbered 35, Series of 2020 entitled, "REGULATING THE CHEWING, SPITTING OF BETEL QUID OR "MOMA" IN PUBLIC PLACES, AND SELLING OF "MOMA" PRODUCTS TO MINORS IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO, IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE."
2. Pursuant to Item (i), Section 14 thereof, all public and private elementary and secondary schools of Baguio City are hereby directed to:
 - 2.1.1. Enforce 100% *moma* free school facilities,
 - 2.1.2. Assist in the monitoring of selling of *moma* from the perimeter of schools to minors, and
 - 2.1.3. Post in clear and conspicuous manner "No Chewing and Spitting" signs, and notices within the school premises and its perimeter.
3. For dissemination and strict compliance.
