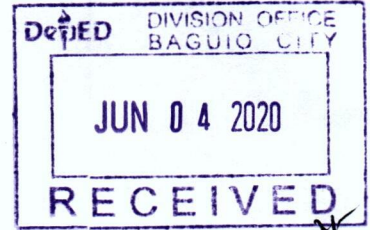

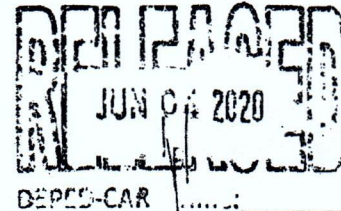

CONDUCT OF END-OF-THE-SCHOOL YEAR RITES FOR SY 2019-2020

1. As contained in DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2019, "The School Year 2019-2020 shall formally open on Monday, June 3, 2019 and shall end on Friday, April 3, 2020. The school calendar for SY 2019-2020 sets March 30-April 3, 2019 as schedule of the end of school year rites; however, due to COVID-19 pandemic, all school activities were held in abeyance. As stated in DepEd Order No. 2, s. 2020, the schools in consultation with the Parents-Teachers Association (PTA) leadership, may choose to reschedule or forego the holding of the rites, should the public health situation prevent the holding of the rites within a period specified. In view of the above, the Regional Office shall provide strategies that schools may adopt in the conduct of the end-of-school year rites. Employing any of the strategies shall be in consultation with the parents or school stakeholders.
2. All public and private schools are encouraged to employ any of the suggested strategies to formally end the School Year 2019-2020 without imploring face to face or physical mass gathering:
 - a. Schools may conduct virtual end of the school year rites. To manage this, schools need to choose a reliable, secure streaming platform and prepare a graduation ceremony to be launched virtually to an internet audience composed of the graduating class and their family;
 - b. Parents may get the credentials and awards of their children from the school on a scheduled basis; or
 - c. School Heads with the teacher-adviser, in coordination with Barangay Officials, may go on a house to house delivery of diploma and awards of learners.
3. Schools Division Offices shall ensure that all schools are provided the needed technical assistance and monitoring in accordance with existing DepEd, Health, and LGU protocols, guidelines.

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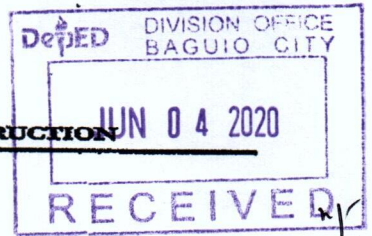


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

TEACHING AND LEARNING RESOURCES BASED ON MELCs

In reference to DM-CI dated May 06, 2020, teachers are tasked to prepare weekly Learning Activity Sheets based on the specific contexts of their learners. In support of this pronouncement, the Multigrade Program Team prepared an inventory of Multigrade teaching and learning resources based on the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs), which will serve as teacher's guide in developing said learning activities in Multigrade schools. The inventory contains instructional materials specially developed for teaching Multigrade classes. These materials include the Multigrade Budget of Work (MG BOW), the MG Daily Lesson Plan Exemplars (MG-DLPs), and the Integrated Multigrade Lesson Plan Exemplars (IMG-LPs) in different learning areas and grade level combinations.

The MG-DLPs and IMG-LPs were designed with Learning Resources (LRs), comprising activity sheets for enrichment and reinforcement of learning as well as formative tasks with rubrics. These materials were carefully developed by competent multigrade teachers, school leaders, district supervisors, and education program supervisors in partnership with UNICEF Philippines and the Basic Education Sector Transformation (BEST) program of the Australian government.

In view of this, all Division Multigrade Program Coordinators are requested to facilitate the dissemination of the said inventory of Multigrade teaching and learning resources to all multigrade teachers, which can be downloaded from this link: <http://bit.ly/InventoryofMGResources>. 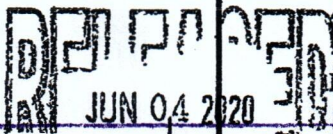
