SUBMISSION OF SELF LEARNING MODULES (SLMs) for PILOT TESTING

1. Pursuant to the Department of Education Memorandum CI-2020-000 dated May 6, 2020, entitled Clarification on the Use of the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) and Other Related Issues, the Schools Division Offices are directed to utilize the MELC as primary reference in determining and implementing learning approaches that are suited to the local context and diversity of learners, while adapting to the challenges posed by COVID-19.
