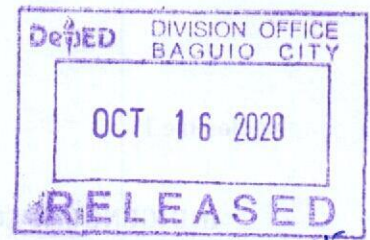

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## Enclosure 1

### **INDIGENOUS PEOPLES (IP) PRODUCTS AND PRACTICES SHOWCASING COMMUNITY RESILIENCE DURING PANDEMIC**

#### **General Guidelines and Mechanics**

1. Each District shall showcase a video documentary unique practices/efforts which focuses on community resilience amidst this pandemic with the IP Month Celebration theme: "*Hamon ng Pandemya Ating Harapan, Gabay ang Katutubong karunungan at Giting*".
2. A **10 to 15-minute** documentary presentation shall be prepared to feature the theme in paragraph number 1.
3. All activities shall strictly adhere to both IP community and national protocols for wellbeing and safety. It is also reiterated that the conduct of the activities is to be guided by the Development's Guidelines on the Conduct of the Activities and Use of Materials Involving Aspects of Indigenous Peoples Culture (DO 51 s. 2014).
4. The following documentary on IP Products and Practices Showcasing Community Resilience shall be prepared by the 10 districts (both A and B or any of the activity).

**A. IKSP Documentary-** a documentary showcasing community resilience will be presented.

#### **Mechanics:**

1. Each district shall feature stories that would heighten IP knowledge, skills, and values to our young generation.
2. The documentary presentation shall be prepared to feature IP themes that may focus on any of the following: (Choose only one theme for your district)
  - Community resilience **amidst this pandemic**
  - Psychosocial support to an IP family in the pursuit of education in this pandemic time
  - The IP Learner in the Blog of ALS
  - "Estoryan Alapo"-interview with old folks on community life
  - Original prayer in the form of chant or song to be presented by the composer/s (Lyrics or wordings included in the package)

#### **B. Product Showcase**

Choose any of the following envisioned outputs:

- Any of the useful products from Recycling, Reusing, Reducing (3Rs) with Cordillera –inspired design output  
(Example: Handicraft, basketry, woodcarving, pottery, weaving, sculpture, souvenir product making etc.)
  - Food recipe unique to the Cordilleras using ingredients from the locality (Kiniing/etag, pinikpikan, wine making, binungur, pinallit, inandila, tinafalu, sinursur , nilapet, suman, pinuneg etc.)
  - Artistic masterpiece in the form of drawing or painting using any media, highlighting the theme for IP month (paragraph 1).
5. Submit edited video documentaries to the SDO Baguio through email at [depedbaguio.lrmads@gmail.com](mailto:depedbaguio.lrmads@gmail.com) on or before **October 23, 2020**.
  6. Video documentaries per District shall be featured via zoom/fblive during the SDO-Baguio IP Culminating activity on October 28,2020.



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7. One video documentary shall be selected at random to participate to Regional IKSP Documentary on October 27, 2020 and Product Showcase on October 28,2020 through the DamiKnow You Tube Channel.
8. All video shall also be uploaded in the SDO-Baguio LR One Stop Shop for educational purposes.
9. Certificate of Recognition shall be given by the SDO to participants in this activity.



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
