



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 156, Series of 2020

RECONSTITUTING THE PLASTIC AND STYROFOAM FREE BAGUIO TASK FORCE, PROVIDING FOR ITS ROLES AND DUTIES

WHEREAS, despite serious efforts of the City to segregate compostable waste from recyclable waste, the continuous usage of single use plastic and Styrofoam as packaging and food vessels continue to become a health hazard to all living species and organisms;

WHEREAS, the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* (City Council) of the City of Baguio had passed City Ordinance of Baguio Numbered No. 35, Series of 2017, otherwise known as "*The Plastic and Styrofoam Free Baguio Ordinance*";

WHEREAS, there is an urgency to regulate the distribution, sale, and use of plastic carry/shopping bags and styrofoam containers in the City of Baguio, so as to implement measures that penalize violations of the provisions of City Ordinance of Baguio Numbered 35, Series of 2017; and providing penalties for violation as stipulated in the Ordinance No. 35, Series of 2017;

NOW THEREFORE, I, BENJAMIN B. MAGALONG, City Mayor, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare:

SECTION 1. The Plastic and Styrofoam Free Baguio Task Force is hereby reorganized, and shall be composed of the following:

Chairperson: City Environment and Parks Management Office

Vice-Chairperson: City General Services Office

Members:

- City Mayor's Office-Permits and Licensing Division
- Public Order and Safety Division
- Special Services Division
- Public Information Office

- City Treasurer's Office
- City Treasurer's Office-City Market Division

Wastewater, Water and Ambient Air

- City General Services Office-
Solid Waste Management Division

- Baguio City Police Office

- Department of Education-Baguio City
Punong Barangays of Baguio City, through their respective

SECTION 2. The Plastic and Styrofoam Free Baguio Task Force shall have the following roles and duties:

- a. Enforce and implement City Ordinance of Baguio Numbered 35, Series of 2017;
- b. Lead in the information and education campaign of programs supporting a Plastic and Styrofoam Free Baguio;
- c. Issue Notices of Violation and citation tickets indicating the corresponding penalty or reprimand for violations of the above named ordinance;
- d. Submit to the City General Services Office a weekly report with copies of Notices of Violation and/or citation tickets, if any, for proper monitoring on the effectivity of the above named ordinance;
- e. Confiscate and seize prohibited plastic carry/shopping bag/s and styrofoam to be turned over at the Public Order and Safety Division, together with the violators to avoid untoward cases and complaints against the Task Force; and
- f. Spearhead the orientation and training for the Barangay officials deputized to implement the Ordinance.

SECTION 3. The Punong Barangay, and Barangay Kagawad assigned on Environmental Protection, in each of the 128 Barangays of Baguio City are hereby deputized to enforce the provisions of City of Baguio Ordinance Numbered 35, Series of 2017 their respective territorial jurisdiction.

SECTION 4. The Public Information Office and Special Services Division of the City Mayor's Office are hereby directed to cause the widest dissemination of this Order;

SECTION 5. All existing issuances and order inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed amended and/or modified accordingly;

SECTION 6. If any part or provision of the Order is held invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts or provisions not affected shall remain valid and effective.

SECTION 7. This shall take effect immediately upon approval


