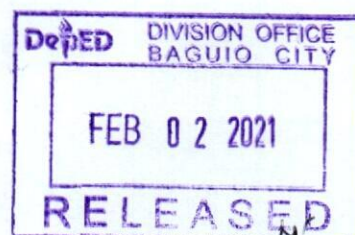

CAPACITY BUILDING ON CHILD RIGHTS AND CHILD PROTECTION

To : Public School District Supervisors
Public School Heads
Child Protection Coordinators / Advisers
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2021 dated January 15, 2021 on *"Creation of the Child Protection Unit and the Child Rights in Education Desk in the Department of Education"*, SDO Baguio City fully recognizes the rights of the child and takes proactive measures to uphold not only the right of the child to special protection but also the other rights of the child in the context of basic education. The Department, in upholding the right of the child to special protection and reiterating its policy of zero tolerance for any act of abuse and violence against the child, issued DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 titled Policy Guidelines on Protecting Children in School from Abuse, Violence, Exploitation, Discrimination, Bullying and Other Forms of Abuse, also known as the DepEd Child Protection Policy. The needs of children are multi-dimensional. Their education should therefore be multi-faceted, in consonance with the duty of the State to promote and protect their holistic development through the promotion of their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being, and to recognize their vital role in nation-building (1987 Constitution, Article II, Sec. 13).
2. The objectives of this activity are as follows:
 - a. To discuss the updates, status, and positive reinforcement on Child Protection, Covid – 19 Parenting and Daliriskwela.
 - b. To acquire skills on how to conduct cybersafe classroom sessions.
 - c. To be acquainted with necessary protocols in responding to disclosures of cyber use and violence from children.
3. In fulfillment of the holistic development of the child, the School Governance Operations Division – Youth Formation envisions child-centered and child caring basic education schools, learning centers, and offices, which respect, protect, promote, and fulfill the dignity and rights of the child in basic education so they may lead productive and happy lives as they participate in nation-building. For this purpose, the Capacity Building on Child Rights and


