

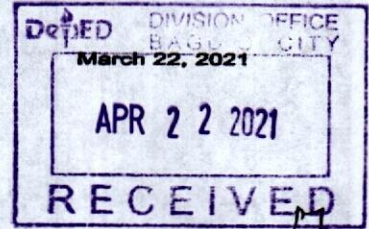

By way of background, our organization caters to the promotion of visual and creative excellence in scholastic journalism. It is actually the same organization behind the success of the two seasons of the BDCP Awards, the first and only award-giving body for campus paper design that aims to recognize visual and creative excellence showcased through news designs of the country's campus newspapers.

This year, the BDCP is holding the first-ever National Campus Media Olympiad (NCPO), a national online journalism tournament which features series of competition for grade school, high school and college students, with the theme: *Promoting Multi-Platform Campus Journalism in Community Building and Development* on March 20 – June 20, 2021.

In view of this, we are inviting students, campus journalists, teachers, school paper advisers, and school heads of your region to join the NCPO 2021.

Participants of the event will be required to pay a registration fee of P100 for individual events, P200 for the duo, P300 for the trio and P500 for team events (inclusive of e-certificate and awards for the winner). There will be no limit on the number of students/participants per publication.



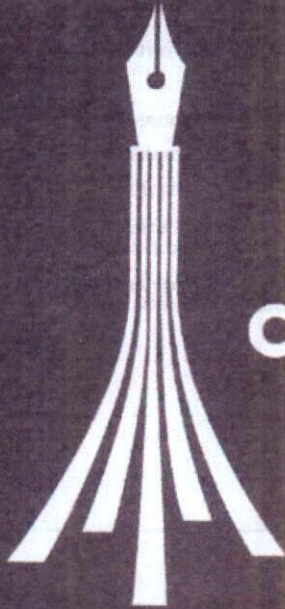

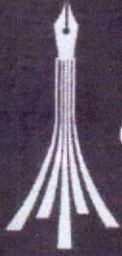

NATIONAL CAMPUS PRESS OLYMPIAD 2021 (The Philippine Campus Journalism Tournament)

To promote the role of campus journalism in empowering communities especially in the midst of a pandemic, the BDCP Designers and Creatives PH, Inc. in cooperation with Aloha Events and Marketing Solutions will be holding the first-ever National Campus Media Olympiad, a national online journalism tournament which will feature a series of competitions for grade school, high school and college students, with the theme: *Promoting Community Development through Multi-Platform Campus Journalism* on March 20–June 20, 2021.

The National Campus Press Olympiad is open to all campus journalists from public and private schools and / or institutions in the Philippines:

Baby Bracket: Elementary Pupils

Bracket A: Grade 7-9

Bracket B: Grade 10 to 1st Year College

Bracket C: 2nd to 4th Year College

- To emphasize the importance of multi-platform campus journalism in the new normal
- To promote news literacy among campus journalists;
- To highlight the role of campus press in community building and development;
- To exercise creativity and freedom through campus journalism; and

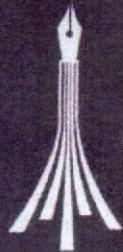

Winning entries will be featured in the BDCP Digest, the official campus journalism folio of BDCP. While the organizers plan to give awards to winners in every category, the board of judges shall have the discretion not to award any prize if in its judgment, no meritorious entry has been submitted.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Pre-Registration is required for the participants in the main events. Registration guidelines and schedule are posted in the official event's page of NCPO 2021.
- Students under Baby Bracket Category will only be allowed to join the Print and Visual Media Events (see list).
- Participants will be required to pay a registration fee (inclusive of e-certificates and awards for winners) for the main events. There will be no registration fee for all the side events.
- There will be no limit on the number of students / participants per publication/school. Participants may also join in as many categories they wish to participate as long as there is no conflict in the schedule of competitions.
- Plagiarism in any form is not allowed in the competition and is a solid ground for disqualification. Plagiarism is defined as the representation of another author's language, thoughts, ideas, or expressions as one's own original work.
- The mechanics and criteria for judging of each event will be posted on the official Facebook page of National Campus Press Olympiad and sent to the provided emails of the participants.
- By submitting an entry, each contestant grants the organizer the permission to publish it and use it for future promotions. Rights remain to the author who may republish the output anywhere else.
- Entries will be judged by known writers, editors, layout artists, graphic designers, campus publication specialists, art / creative directors, photojournalists, media educators, and journalists from different renowned news agencies, publishing industries, and institutions.
- There will be ten (10) finalists per category, medium and bracket where the top 3 winners will be named, recognized and awarded.

HOW TO REGISTER

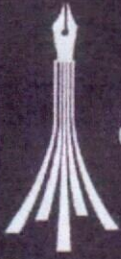
- Registration fees shall be collected per team. A picture of the proof of payment must be attached in the google registration form.

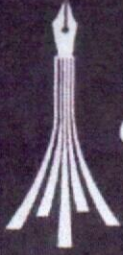

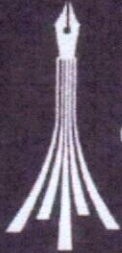
