

VIDEO PRESENTATION OF INNOVATIVE PRACTICES

To : CID and SGOD Chief Education Supervisors

Public School District Supervisors Education Program Supervisors

Public and Private School Heads and Administrators

All Others Concerned

- 1. In line with the implementation of the 2020 Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP), a virtual knowledge sharing series of best practices on the multiple learning delivery modalities of all public, and interested private schools with the theme, "SDO Baguio: Go Blended Towards a Smart City" are requested to submit a 5-minute audio-video presentation on or before April 29, 2021 through the link provided at https://depedpines.com/.
- 2. This activity aims to:
 - serve as a platform for learning of best practices from other schools for benchmarking,
 - 2.2 profile innovative practices of schools along with the multiple learning delivery modalities,
 - 2.3 establish partnership and collaboration between and among schools, and
 - 2.4 demonstrate the practice of school-based management amid pandemic
- 3. To ensure quality video presentation, the following guidelines on AVP Production Format should be taken into consideration which are as follows:
 - 3.1 Must be at least HD 720p (1280x720pixels) in MP4 format.
 - 3.2 Must not exceed 5 minutes.
 - 3.3 No use of copyrighted music.
 - 3.4 Must be with clear narration (no background noise, record narration in a silent space/area).
 - 3.5 Avoid long blocks of text.
 - 3.6 Avoid flashy transitions (fade in, fade out transition is recommended).
 - 3.7 No text to speech.
 - 3.8 Consider transition timing and readability of texts/captions.
 - 3.9 Intro must not exceed 10 seconds.
 - 3.10 For easier preparation, first draft a script, record narration then set/layout relevant images and video clips accordingly.
 - 3.11 Use of overlays, green screens, sound and video fx, storytelling, vlogging and other elements and techniques for effective presentation is highly encouraged.
- 4. Participants per batch are the public elementary and secondary school heads, assistant school heads, head teachers, grade level coordinators, interested administrators of private schools in the district, reactors and synthesizers (See Enclosure 1 for the list of participants per batch).









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- 5. Each school is required to prepare a 5- minute audio-video presentation essential and crucial elements as follows:
 - 5.1 conduct of teaching and learning,
 - 5.2 conduct of delivery and retrieval,
 - 5.3 conduct of assessment,
 - 5.4 provisions of interventions/ strategies to learners who did not meet expectations and with incomplete grades,
 - 5.5 provision of technical assistance to schools, teachers, and learning support aides,
 - 5.6 practices of School-Based Management along with curriculum and instruction as regards to decision-making based on school context
- 6. Reactors and synthesizers will give their feedback based on the guidelines below (see Enclosure 2 for the reactor's marking sheet template).
 - 6.1 Guidelines for Reactors
 - a. Focus on description rather than judgement.
 - b. Focus on observation rather than inference.
 - c. Share both positive and constructive specific points of the presentation.
 - d. Focus on the most important points to be improved.
 - e. Feedback should be specific and clear.

6.2 Guidelines for Synthesizers

- a. Summarize briefly all presentations.
- b. Discuss similarities and differences between and among the presentations in a way that the synthesis is as informative as possible.
- c. Conclude the presentations by reminding the viewers of the most significant themes and the way they connect to the overall topicinnovative practices on the implementation of multiple learning delivery modalities.
- 7. The Public School District Supervisors will coordinate the activity of their respective districts.
- 8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.


