Since 2006, the EIU/GCED Best Practices have introduced 49 inspiring practices by educators in the Asia-Pacific region. To further encourage practitioners' participation in the field, the programme has been closely linked to APCEIU's EIU/GCED capacity-building programmes and networks. This approach has not only helped to identify and disseminate good practices but also brought positive results in encouraging participants of APCEIU's training workshops to continue their efforts on the ground after the completion of the workshops.

Clear Statement of Request and Recommendation

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be an educational practitioner currently working in the field of EIU/GCED
- The submitted programme/project must have been carried out upon submission
- Project proposals or programmes/projects still in the planning and implementation stages will not be accepted.
- Applicant must have good spoken and written English

Summary Report of Selected Cases

- Selected participants are required to submit their Best Practice case in the form of a summary report (15 to 20 pages) and their brief CV
- Upon selection, the applicant will be provided with the terms of reference and guidelines for the summary report

Each selected applicant will be honoured with the Global Citizen Award and prize money at an award ceremony organized by APCEIU. A total of five EIU/GCED Best Practices will be selected. A screening committee composed of APCEIU staff and international experts on EIU/GCED (appointed by APCEIU) will review the submitted applications and decide upon the programmes/projects.

The deadline for submission is on or before 14 June 2021.
