Division Implementation of Brigada Pagbasa During the 2021 Brigada Eskwela Implementation

1. Pursuant to the DepEd Memorandum No. 053, s. 2020 on the Joint Implementing Guidelines for Brigada Eskwela and Oplan Balik Eskwela, Enclosure No. 2 on Brigada Eskwela Mandated Partnership Activities and Stakeholders' Engagement under the New Normal, this Office amidst pandemic happening around the world, is still committed to extend Quality learning at home. It continuously aims to elevate reading level for K to Grade 6 learners by intensifying its campaign of establishing reading at home through project "Mag-aaral Mo. Pabasahin Mo".
2. The project aims to:
 - a. educate the parents on how to be a reading teacher at home; and
 - b. provide reading materials that can be used by struggling, frustration, instructional and independent readers.
3. Series of videos shall be posted on DepEd Tayo Baguio to help parents on How to Teach Reading at home.
4. Reading materials suitable to the needs of the learners were compiled at the LR One stop shop to be downloaded by the ELLN Coordinator to be given to parents for their ward or child.
5. School heads and ELLN Coordinators are requested to encourage parents to be part of this project through their General PTA Officers, alumni association, and barangay officials.
6. This project shall be continued even after this situation. This Office suggests various activities to make sure that awareness campaign will be intensified:
 - a. Pabasa sa Barangay- A reading task force of each school will visit nearby barangay to conduct webinar symposia and fora.
 - b. Brigada Basa-inclusion of reading at home information drive in the month-long Brigada Eskwela activities.
 - c. Other school initiated projects which aim to involve parents in teaching reading (All ELLN Coordinators are required to craft their Action Plan for the Brigada Pagbasa).
7. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
