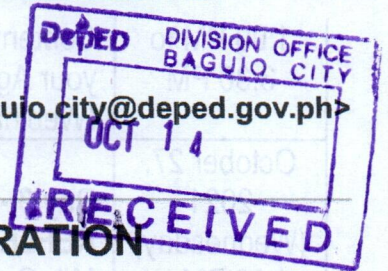

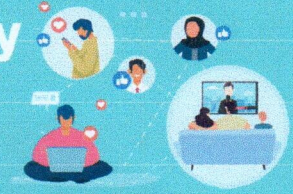

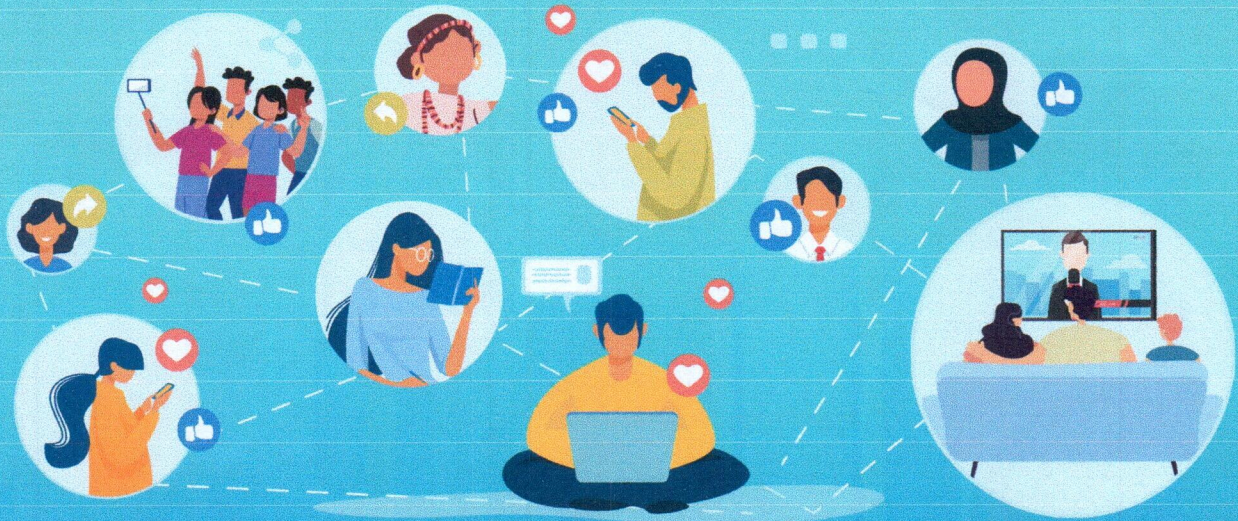

What is Global Media and Information Literacy (MIL) Week?



The Global MIL Week is an annual celebration spearheaded by UNESCO every last week of October. It is a major occasion for its stakeholders to review and celebrate the progress achieved towards "Media and Information Literacy for All."

UNESCO and UNESCO Media and Information Literacy Alliance call for all MIL champions worldwide to promote Global MIL Week by organizing and registering online or offline activities.

The 10th Global MIL Week theme is "Media and Information Literacy for the Public Good." The celebration will be hosted by South Africa from October 24-31, 2021.

The theme will focus on how the global community can use Global MIL Week to build MIL as key to a vision of information as a public good. Freedom of expression, countering hate speech, and the right to information are central topics to this year's Global MIL Week.
