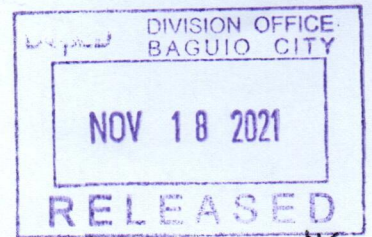

1. Pursuant to Section 43 of Article IV of R.A. No. 9165 otherwise known as the “Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002”, the Department of Education reiterates its support to the National Drug Education Program (NDEP). The NDEP is a comprehensive educational program which provides for a holistic approach to the problem of drug abuse. It was designed to enable all sectors to work collaboratively, with the school system as the core, thereby, unifying all sectoral endeavors. It is implemented in schools to create awareness on the ill effects of abusing drugs and to develop among students’ positive behavior and life skills to resist drugs. The School Governance and Operations Division - Youth Formation Division and Sto Tomas National High School will conduct a division-wide wevinar for students, parents and teachers of DepEd-BaguiO City on **November 22-24, 2021 at 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon.**
