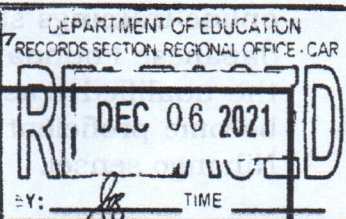

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Curriculum Development - Special Curricular Programs Division (BCD-SCPD), shall open its application to public secondary school teachers interested to be part of Batch 6 for the **Special Program in Foreign Language-Japanese (SPFL-Japanese) training**. The qualified teachers for **Batch 6** shall undergo an enTrée and follow-through online trainings starting in 2022. The successful candidates shall be notified by the Japanese Foundation-Manila through email and an issuance of a DepEd memo for the qualified teachers follows. The benefits of the program provide an avenue to become proficient in Nihongo, an opportunity to study in Japan, and to become a Nihongo sensei.

The following are the requirements to be complied with by the teacher-applicant:

1. Teacher's qualification must be aligned with DO no. 68, s. 2009
2. Service Record
3. Letter of Intent to be endorsed by the school principal addressed to the Bureau Director IV Jocelyn DR Andaya
4. Curriculum Vitae (CV) and or Personal Data Sheet (PDS) of the teacher-candidate
5. Number of Junior High School students interested in the program duly certified by the school principal
6. Stable/strong internet connectivity for online training
7. Must be 36 years old or below.
