2022 ONLINE HOME-BASED DIVISION BIBLE QUIZ BEE

February 18, 2022
Division of City Schools
Baguio City

RATIONALE:

Presidential Proclamation Nos. 44, s. of 1986 and 1067, s. 1997, declares every last week of January of every year as National Bible Week. Presidential Proclamation No. 124, s. 2017, recognizes the religious nature of the Filipino people and declaring the whole Month of January of every year as National Bible Month culminating in the last week of January as the National Bible Week. Certain activities pursued in the exercise of religious freedom contribute to the attainment of this goal are received, encouraged and supported by the government.

Department of the Interior and Local Government Memorandum Circular No. 2017-111 dated August 25, 2017 states that all Local Government Units either Provincial, City, Municipal, Barangay, ARMM, Regional and DILG Regional Directors are enjoined to support the advocacy and seeing moral development among the Filipino people through the transforming power of the word of God.

Baguio City Council Resolution No. 173 s. 2008 entitled "Declaring the 4th Week of January and every year thereafter as National Bible Week in the City of Baguio" states that the Baguio Character Council, in coordination with the faith community and the Philippine Bible Society will lead and formulate the necessary activities of the National Bible Week Celebration and one of the activities is the conduct of a Bible Quiz Bee.

OBJECTIVE:

A fun way to motivate individuals to study God's Word and meditate on the scriptures through a healthy competition. It aims to develop Bible reading to raise awareness of Biblical truth among the citizenry and strengthen the conviction that God's word is the basic foundation of a happy and peaceful life.

DESCRIPTION:

The Bible Quiz Bee shall test the learner's knowledge and understanding on the practices and beliefs that promote peace by answering questions derived from the Bible



OBJECTIVES:

The Bible Quiz Bee aims to showcase learner's skills on the following:

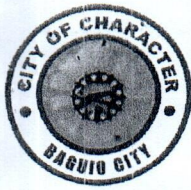
1. Mastery level on the content of the Bible; and,
2. Display the value of unity and sportsmanship among the participants.

SOURCE TEXT:

Coverage of the Bible Quiz Bee questions will be from Genesis to Revelations. All questions will be in English.

GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

1. This activity requires utmost honesty and obedience from the participants.
2. The participants in the competition will be 3 qualified representatives from the 10 districts in Baguio City Division, both from elementary (Grade 4-6 only) and Junior High School.
3. Participants must have stable internet connection.
4. The conduct of the online Bible Quiz will be via Zoom (opening program and orientation) and Kahoot (Quiz Bee Proper).
5. All questions will be derived from the New American Standard Bible.
6. The quiz will be done on a single round bases; all questions will be multiple choice in nature.
7. Participants are allotted 10 seconds to answer. Answers given after 10 seconds will not be checked and counted.
8. Kahoot will then show the ranking of the participants after each question.
9. All participants must join the opening program at 8:00 AM.
10. All participants will only open kahoot once the contest proper starts and no other tabs should be opened.
11. The officials will be the Quiz Master and Facilitator.



During the Contest

1. Go to kahoot.com
2. Participants will enter the Pin # in Kahoot! Mobile app or at **kahoot.it** on their devices (computer or mobile) and click Enter.
3. Students will enter a username with the following format:
The School acronym-Nickname i.e. **(BCNHS-Juana)** then click OK.
4. Click Start on the screen to begin the game.
5. Participants are given 10 seconds to answer each question.
6. Questions and choices will be displayed on the screen. Note:
Choices are color coded and participants will click on the color corresponding their answers.
7. Once the participants answered a particular question, the correct answer and a bar graph with the overall snapshot of the class responses will be displayed on the instructor's screen.

After the Contest

1. Once the game is done, winner information will be displayed in the Podium and the contestant screen will show their results and rank.
2. After the quiz, the top 5 with most points will be shown to all participants.

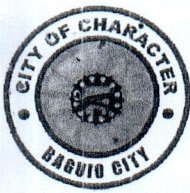
Declaration of Winners:

1. The top 5 scorers will be declared as the winners. They shall be recognized as the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th placers respectively.
2. In cases of ties, clincher questions will be raised to break the tie.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

Team members/contestants are requested to take special note of the Code of Conduct. It should be discussed thoroughly with teams, especially as breaches of the Code are grounds for sanction, which may include disqualification.

- ❖ Team members shall be at all times be respectful in their engagement with team mates, opponents and match officials. Display behavior that are unsportsmanlike or go against the grain of team spirit are included under this standards.
- ❖ Team members must not curse, swear or use profane or coarse language, inadvertently or not
- ❖ Competitors are expected to be honest.




PRIZES:
