6. SDG 13 – Climate Action

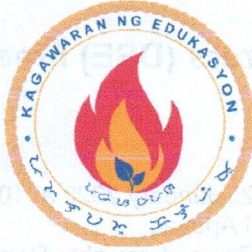



The ASEAN Foundation in partnership with SAP will organise the virtual ASEAN Data Science Explorers' (ASEAN DSE) enablement sessions from 7 February to 31 March 2022. Through the enablement session, we aim to provide a free, comprehensive data analytics training for students, teachers and lecturers across the ten ASEAN Member States using SAP Analytics Cloud (SAC) as the main tool. Furthermore, the enablement session will also help prepare students aged 15 to 30 to participate in the ASEAN DSE competition and for the teachers and lecturers to mentor their students throughout the journey of the competition.

On that note, I would like to kindly request Your Excellencies' assistance to help disseminate the ASEAN DSE's enablement session opportunity to all institutes of higher learning and high schools in Your Excellencies' respective ASEAN Member States. It would be highly appreciated if Your Excellencies could disseminate the enablement session opportunity by **25 January 2022** to allow us to better record and coordinate the incoming registration from students, teachers and lecturers prior to the start of the enablement session.

To give Your Excellency a little bit background, ASEAN DSE is a regional data analytics competition that has been implemented by the ASEAN Foundation in partnership with SAP since 2017. It targets youths aged 15 to 30 taking full-time education to develop data-driven findings and recommendations highlighting social and economic issues across the following six SDGs: (1) SDG 6 – Clean Water and Sanitation, (2) SDG 7 – Clean and Affordable Energy, (3) SDG 8 – Decent Work and Economic Growth, (4). SDG 11 – Sustainable Cities and Communities, (5) SDG 12 – Responsible Consumption and Production, and (6) SDG 13 – Climate Action, using SAP Analytics Cloud. The programme was also recognised by the ten ASEAN leaders as a creative digital initiative at the 31st ASEAN Summit in 2017 in Manila, the Philippines, and as a digital skills development initiative to prepare ASEAN youth to be future-ready at the 35th ASEAN Summit in 2019 in Bangkok, Thailand. Terms of Reference

ASEAN Data Science Explorers (ASEAN DSE) Enablement Session 2022

Background

- The ASEAN Foundation and SAP value the importance of partnerships between the public, private, and plural sectors and the role that youths play as next-generation leaders and changemakers to contribute towards sustainable socio-economic developments in ASEAN Member States
- Riding on the trail of success since 2017, the ASEAN Foundation and SAP have extended the strategic partnership in 2020 for the next three years to continue creating positive impact in ASEAN under two strategic pillars: Education and Entrepreneurship. The flagship initiative under the partnership is the ASEAN Data Science Explorers (ASEAN DSE) competition. ASEAN DSE is a data analytics competition that aims to enhance awareness and appreciation of the ASEAN community amongst ASEAN youth. The competition is open to any youths with the age of 15 to 30 years old undertaking full-time education across the 10 ASEAN Member States. Participants must be nationals of ASEAN member countries only. Further information about ASEAN DSE competition can be found on www.aseandse.org
- By using SAP Analytics Cloud (SAC), the youths participating in the competition are required to analyse data across the six United Nations Sustainable Development Goals: (1) SDG 6 – Clean Water and Sanitation, (2) SDG 7 – Affordable and Clean Energy, (3) SDG 8 – Decent Work and Economic Growth, (4) SDG 11 – Sustainable Cities and Communities, (5) SDG 12 – Responsible Consumption and Production, (6) SDG 13 – Climate Action. They will also be required to identify the main problem/issue using the analysed data and propose data analysis/analytics-backed solutions/recommendations to address the issue/problem.
- Prior to the competition, the ASEAN Foundation will be conducting **FREE** enablement sessions: SAC training sessions.
- The enablement sessions are offered to any interested institutes of higher learning (universities, polytechnics, colleges) and high schools in the ASEAN region to help students and lecturers familiarise themselves with SAC for data analysis and analytics. Any institute of higher learning and high school keen to host the enablement session is required to send email to Mr. ILAN ASQOLANI, Project Manager for the ASEAN Foundation-SAP Joint initiatives, through his email: ilan.asqolani@aseanfoundation.org by 31 January 2022, expressing the interest to host the session.

Objectives

The enablement session aims to:

- Get students, teachers, and lecturers familiar with SAC as one of the platforms for data analysis and analytics which they can use for their academic and non-academic purposes
- Allow students, teachers, and lecturers to explore data analytics skills and other relevant skills (critical thinking, analytical thinking, and problem-solving skills) using SAC
- Encourage eligible students to participate in ASEAN DSE competition: www.aseandse.org
- Encourage teachers and lecturers to be the mentors for their students to participate in ASEAN DSE competition
- Promote ASEAN awareness among students, teachers, and lecturers across the ASEAN region

Details

- The enablement session targets students, teachers, and lecturers, who are keen to learn about SAC, data analysis/analytics, and data science
- The enablement session facilitator will be an SAP employee having expertise in SAC
- The session is conducted for 25 – 30 participants (students and teachers/lecturers)
- Each session is conducted for about 4 – 5 hours with breaks
- 30 shared SAC accounts will be provided for all participants during the session with validity until 31 December 2022
- All the 25 – 30 participants are **COLLECTIVELY REQUIRED** to conduct another enablement session(s) (post-enablement session(s)) for at least 200 students within three months after the enablement session. There will be no additional session with SAP facilitator after the enablement session is completed. Consultation via emails with SAP facilitator after the enablement session is still possible.
- Any student, teacher, or lecturer who has contributed to the facilitation of the post-enablement session(s) for min. 200 students will be provided with a certificate of achievement as a facilitator, issued by the ASEAN Foundation and SAP. He/she will also be given a dedicated access to SAC for FREE using his/her username and password. Normally the access costs appr. USD 21/month

What to be provided by an Institute of Higher Learning/High School to host the enablement session?

- Prepare an online meeting/learning platform (Zoom, Google Meet, Microsoft Teams, etc.) to host a 4 to 5-hour virtual enablement session
- Ensure that all participants have access to the Internet connection to access SAC throughout the entire enablement session
- Ensure that each participant has access to a laptop or PC throughout the whole session.
- **A MANDATORY COMMITMENT LETTER** signed by a relevant university faculty member (dean/vice dean, president/vice president, rector/vice rector, or head of department) or school principal, highlighting the institute's or high school's commitment to conduct post-

enablement session(s) for a minimum of 200 students within three months after the enablement session AND commitment to promote ASEAN DSE competition to their all students

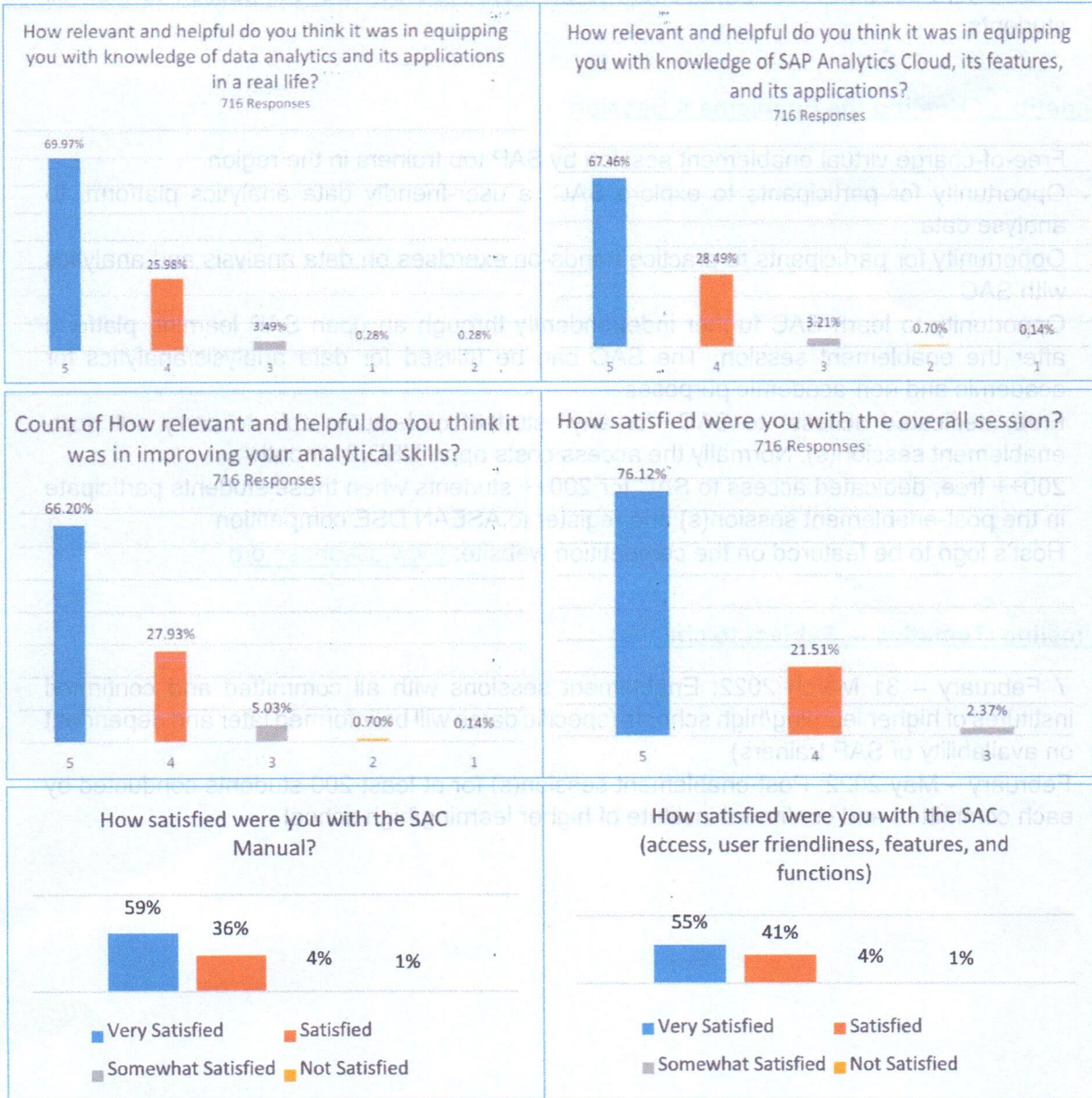
Benefits of Hosting the Enablement Session

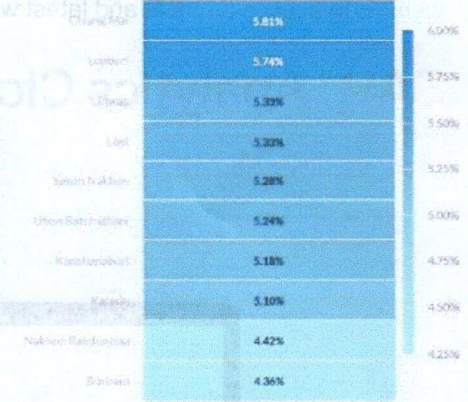
