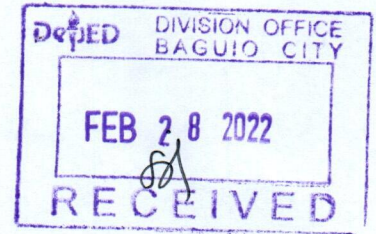

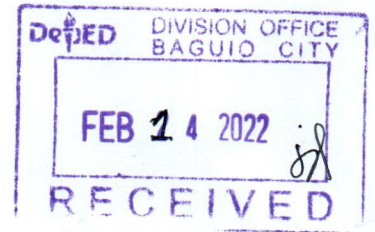

In line with this, we would like to ask for your support by endorsing our research to all public junior high schools in Baguio City. Specifically, we would like to request the following from your good office:

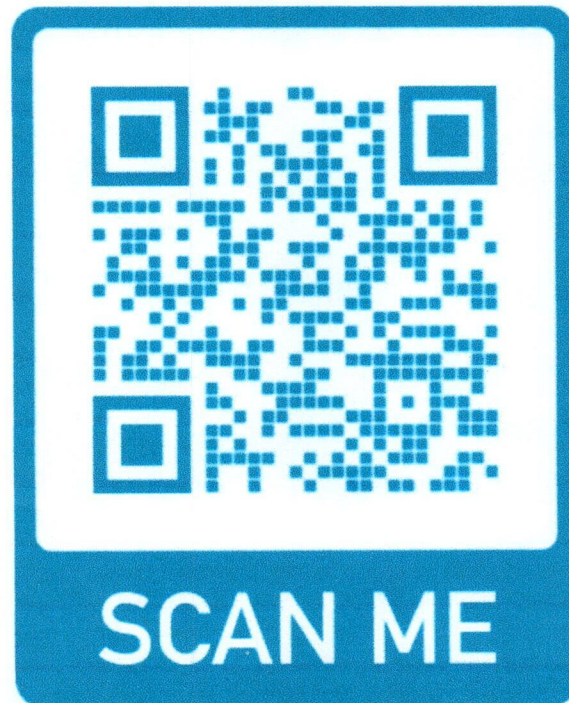
