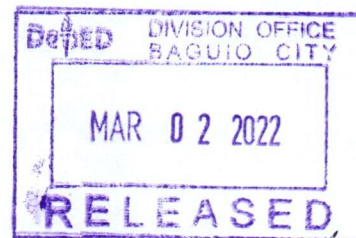

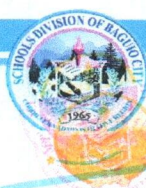
CONDUCT OF 2022 WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

1. DepEd- Baguio City shall conduct a month long celebration of Women's Month (WM) this March 2022. This activity will serve as a venue to highlight women's achievements and discuss continuing and emerging women's empowerment and gender equality issues and concerns, challenges, and commitments on with the theme "We Make Change Work for Women". This pursuit of development is also anchored on the commitment of "Malasakit at Pagbabago" or True Compassion and Real Change. (Republic Act (RA) 6949)
2. To commence the activity, a kick off program will be conducted on **March 8, 2022 at Division Office Training Hall, 8:00 AM-4:00 PM** through blended learning modality. This aims to facilitate platforms to discuss good practices, gaps, challenges, and commitments in pursuing Gender and Development (GAD) – to strengthen implementation of the Magna Carta of Women. This platform shall likewise serve as a way to provide assistance to women in the aspect of legal, health, privileges and others.
