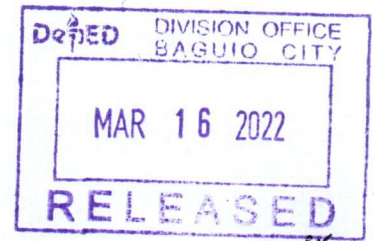

SCHOOL PARTICIPATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES – CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION’S (DENR-CAR) TALAKAYAN SA PAARALAN

 Public School Heads
 Public School Administrative Officers
 Public School Education Facilities Coordinators, and
 All Others Concerned

1. The DENR-CAR through the Regional Strategic Communication and Initiative Group (RSCIG) will conduct a **Talakayan sa Paaralan** with the different schools. *Talakayan sa Paaralan* is an Information Education Campaign on the priority programs of the DENR which focuses on **school site titling, solid waste management, and geohazard and/or vulnerability assessment**;
2. An audience from the different public schools of Baguio City will be grouped into three (3) batches with maximum participants of fifteen (15) per batch. The activity will be conducted for half day per batch via face-to-face in three (3) identified schools.
3. Considering that the Schools Division Office has been undertaking all efforts in its application for Special Patent for its remaining school sites that are not yet titled, this opportunity must be taken advantage of by public schools which applications for Special Patent are on-going, or with school sites concerns that were coordinated with the SGOD and Legal Unit;
4. The following public schools are therefore required to register two (2) participants from their respective schools, preferably the school heads, and/or school education facility coordinators, and/or school administrative officers:
