INFORMAL READING INVENTORY (Phil.-IRI) PRETEST**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 445 s. 2022 on the Conduct of Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil.-IRI) Pretest, the Division Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) directs all English and Filipino teachers in the Schools Division to conduct the Group Screening Test (GST) and after which is the Pretest to learners in Grades 3-7 in Filipino and Grades 4 to 7 in English. This will be conducted from September to October 10, 2022.
2. The coordinator for Phil.-IRI in schools shall facilitate and collate the results of Pretest by accomplishing the google sheet corresponding to their school on or before October 21, 2022. Link will be provided in the official group chat.
3. Learners who were identified under the frustration level will be provided with necessary interventions such as but not limited to intensive remediation and school home partnership. An intervention plan will be prepared and be submitted to the Schools Division Office for consolidation of Phil.-IRI Division Coordinator and for submission to the Regional Office.
4. Monitoring from the Division and Regional Offices will be conducted to ensure the administration of Phil.-IRI activities.
