RE : INTERNATIONAL DAY OF THE GIRL (IDG) 2022 CELEBRATION

DATE : October 11, 2022

The United Nations declared October 11 as the International Day of the Girl (IDG) in 2012. Since then, for ten years already, Girl Guides and Girl Scouts around the world have been celebrating IDG every year. It is a key moment for the Member Organizations of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) to come together to raise girls' voices and show how the Movement empowers girls and young women to shape the world they want to see.

This year's IDG theme is "Girls Speak Up" which will revolve around global youth consultation in the commitment to making the IDG activities more girl-led in 2032. Prior to the pandemic, the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) usually celebrated IDG with Girl Scouts Got Talent, celebrating girls and showcasing different talents from all over the country. With the onset of COVID-19, the IDG celebration has been shifted to online mode to still deliver the program, albeit remotely.

This 2022, GSP will have a hybrid celebration (virtual and face-to-face) with the following activities:




E-certificate and IDG 2022 badge will be awarded to those who will participate and accomplish all the required activities.


