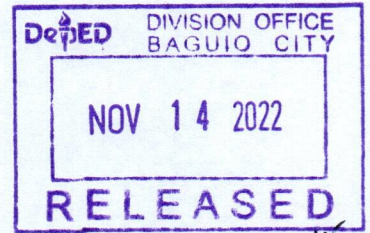

OBSERVANCE OF THE 2022 FILIPINO VALUES MONTH

1. In reference to Presidential Proclamation No. 479 s.1994 declaring the month of November as Filipino Values Month and DepEd Memorandum no. 101 s. 2022 on the 2022 National Observance of the Filipino Values Month, this office through the Curriculum Implementation Division, is conducting the following activities in its celebration with the theme: *"Magagandang Kaugaliang Pilipino: Isabuhay at Pagyamanin Tungo sa Matiwasay at Maunlad na Kinabukasan"*.
 - a. Tagis Talino
 - b. Digital Poster Making
 - c. Video-Sayawit Contest
 - d. Search for Outstanding Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) Teacher
2. The objectives of the activities are the following:
 - a. To facilitate the observance of Filipino Values Month in the Schools Division of Baguio City;
 - b. To inculcate the essence of Filipino Values System with the utilization of various media in the conduct of activities and competitions; and
 - c. To provide an avenue for showcasing the Filipino Core Values through the students, teachers, and other stakeholders' creative participation in the various activities and competitions.
3. The schools shall submit to the Curriculum Implementation Division, through the Education Program Supervisor in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao a report that captures the impact of the celebration of Filipino Values Month. This should comprehensively describe the general nature of activities conducted, involvement of stakeholders, observations/findings, issues/concerns and recommendations. 4. Please see enclosure 2 for the Guidelines/Mechanics of judging of the different competitions.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

**OBSERVANCE OF THE 2022 FILIPINO VALUES MONTH
(HYBRID (VIRTUAL/ONLINE & ONSITE))**

1. TAGIS TALINO

Guidelines and Mechanics

1. This activity requires utmost honesty and obedience from the participants.
2. The qualified participants are the top 1 district winners from both public elementary and secondary (Junior High)
3. Participants must have stable internet connection.
4. The conduct of the online Tagis Talino will be via Zoom (opening program and orientation) and Kahoot (Tagis Talino Proper).
5. The coverage of the Tagis Talino includes the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELC), Content and performance standards of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao from Grade 4 to grade 6 (Elementary) and Grade 7 to Grade 10 (Secondary). The EsP Education Program Supervisor will prepare questions. Ten (10) questions per category (Easy, Average & Difficult-one point (i) will be given to each question.
6. Participants are allotted 10 seconds to answer. Answers given after 10 seconds will not be checked and counted.
7. Kahoot will then show the ranking of each participant after each question.
8. All participants must join the opening program at 8:00 AM.
9. All participants will only open kahoot once the contest proper starts and no other tabs will be opened.
10. The officials will be the Quiz Master and Facilitator.
11. Board of judges –EsP EPS and EsP Head Teachers
12. Schedule Division Tagis Talino – November 29, 2022

During the Contest

1. Go to kahoot.com
2. Participants will enter the Pin # in Kahoot! Mobile app or at **kahoot.it** on their devices (computer or mobile) and click Enter.
3. Students enter a nickname and click OK, go! button, which will populate on their screen in the game lobby. Note: Participants need to enter their **School-Name (BCNHS-Juana Dela Paz)**
4. Click Start on the screen to begin the game.
5. Participants are given 10 seconds to answer each question.
6. Questions and choices will be displayed on the screen. Note: Choices are color coded and participants will click on the color corresponding their answers.
7. Once the participants answered a particular question, the correct answer and a bar graph with the overall snapshot of the class responses will be displayed on the instructor's screen.

After the Contest

1. Once the game is over, winner information will be displayed in the Podium and the contestant screen will show their results and rank.
2. After the tagis talino, the top 3 with most points will be shown to all participants.

Declaration of Winners:

1. The top three (3) scorers will be declared as winners. They shall be recognized as the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd placers respectively.
2. In cases of ties, clincher questions will be raised to break the tie.
3. Certificates await the winner

2. DIGITAL POSTER MAKING

Guidelines and Mechanics

1. The qualified participants are the top 1 district winners from both public elementary and Junior High
2. The entry must depict, interpret, illustrate, and/or emphasize the theme of the 2022 Filipino Values Month, *“Magagandang Kaugaliang Pilipino: Isabuhay at Pagyamanin Tungo sa Matiwasay at Maunlad na Kinabukasan”*.
3. Poster must be in landscape and lay-outed in a size of 8.5 x 11 inches in JPEG/PNG format.
4. For verification purposes, a timelapse video recording of the participant creating the artwork/poster is also required. Non-compliance may mean disqualification.
5. Participants may use **any Editing software** (Photoshop, Paint, etc).
6. All artwork on the poster must be an original design. The artist will be held accountable in cases where issues regarding the originality and authenticity of the design may arise.
7. Appearance of participant’s name, organization’s name or logo, or any product/brand name as a material or content in the poster is not allowed.
8. A written explanation and/or description of the work/entry (in ENGLISH or in FILIPINO) consisting of 100-150 words encoded in a 8.5 x 11 inches must be submitted as a separate attachment.
9. The poster should have not been submitted in previous contests or used/displayed in public.
10. Official entry must include the entry form with the complete name of the learner, complete name of the school, district, contact number and email along with the one-page description of the poster and the time-lapse video of the learner in MP4 format. (See attachments below).
11. Deadline of submission of entries is on November 24, 2022. Submit entries to: **noradalapnas01@gmail.com** with the following attachments:
 - a. One-page explanation and description of the artwork/poster; and
 - b. Time-lapse video of the learner doing the artwork/poster in MP4 format.
12. The top 3 posters which attained the highest average ratings will be proclaimed as winners.
13. The winners will receive a Certificate of Recognition.
14. All qualified participants will receive a Certificate of Participation.
15. The decision of the board of judges selected by the organizers is final and irrevocable.
16. All digital posters submitted shall be considered property of DepEd Baguio under the EPS Values Education.

3. VIDEO-SAYAWIT CONTEST

Contest Rules:

1. The competition is open to all public-Junior High School in the Schools Division of Baguio City.
2. First Place from each district are the participants to the Division Competition.
3. The composition of performers must be minimum of 5 and maximum of 7 (male or female or combination) excluding the instrumentalists.
4. The performance must consist of songs and dance presentation in accordance with the theme: *“Magagandang Kaugaliang Pilipino: Isabuhay at Pagyamanin Tungo sa Matiwasay at Maunlad na Kinabukasan”*.
5. Entries should be original and must in accordance with the copyright laws, music used in the entry must be original, licensed or in the public domain (ask permission from the composer).
6. Contestants will use costumes but the use of props are not allowed.
7. The accompaniment should be live and may use any instruments suited to the whole concept of the presentation.
8. The video-sayawit must run for a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes only including entrance and exit if there are. 5 points will be deducted from the total score for every excess minute in their presentation.

9. Video-sayawit resolution must be at least 720p (1280X720, 25fps frame rate).
10. Entries should not contain any offensive or inappropriate language, image and/or content. The video-sayawit should be appropriate for general viewership.
11. Display of any marketing brands (Stores/Mall, Clothing, Food, etc.) to be used in the video is discouraged.
12. Deadline of submission of entries is on November 24, 2022. Submit entries to:

13. Decision of the judges shall be final and irrevocable.
14. All entries shall be considered property of DepEd Baguio under the EPS Values Education

4. SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAKATAO (EsP) TEACHER

Objectives:

1. To recognize the outstanding achievements of Values Education/EsP Teachers.
2. To uplift the quality of teaching Values in the City of Baguio.

Guidelines for Implementation:

The search is open to all full-time Values Education/EsP Teachers in the Elementary and Secondary public schools, duly nominated by their respective school heads using the prescribed nomination form.

Qualification of a Nominee:

1. Must presently teaching VE/EsP, and must have taught VE/EsP in the elementary and secondary whether in public or private school for three (3) consecutive years or more.
2. Must be recommended by the school head.
3. Must be of good moral character as certified by the school head.
4. Winners in the previous year's search are not qualified to join to give chance to others.

Selection Procedure

1. All supporting documents (within the last three (3) school years (2019-2020, 2020-2021, 2021-2022) submitted by the school nominees shall be rated according to the set of criteria presented below.
