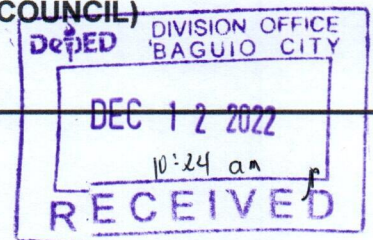

**RESOLUTION Numbered 515  
(Series of 2022)**

ENCOURAGING THE USE OF PERSONAL LUNCH BOX/CONTAINER  
WHEN ORDERING TAKE-OUT FOOD AT THE OFFICE/SCHOOL  
CANTEENS IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO.

WHEREAS, preparing and packing a meal before going to school or office is a burden to many because of the rush to be on time. Instead of packed lunch, people simply line-up to the school or office canteen for meals;

WHEREAS, the practice of buying take-out foods from canteens may sound convenient and saves time, however, these are usually served in disposable containers which contribute to a huge volume of biodegradable wastes being addressed by the city;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003<sup>1</sup>, otherwise known as the “Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000,” mandates the setting of guidelines and targets for solid waste avoidance and volume reduction;

WHEREAS, through Ordinance Numbered 18, Series of 2016 or the Environment Code of the City of Baguio, the city has provided strategy for the reduction of solid and liquid wastes to further abate the deterioration of the environment and its natural resources;

WHEREAS, the high-level waste production due continuous and relentless disposal of single-use food containers brings serious, irreversible effects and much harm to the environment and the ecosystem; and

WHEREAS, the practice of using personal lunch box instead of disposable containers would greatly help reduce the volume of city wastes and an opportunity for the stakeholders to contribute their share in the conservation of the environment through waste reduction:

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Tabanda, Hon. Bomogao, Hon. Yaranon and Hon. Orcales, duly seconded, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to encourage the use of personal lunch box/container when ordering take-out food at the office/school canteens in the City of Baguio.
